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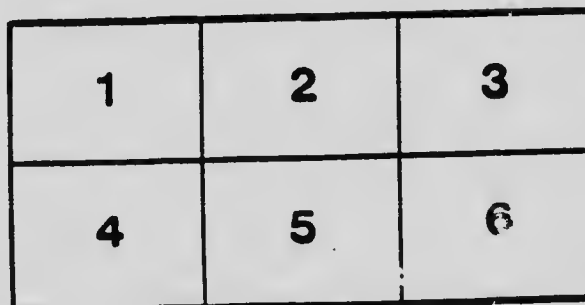
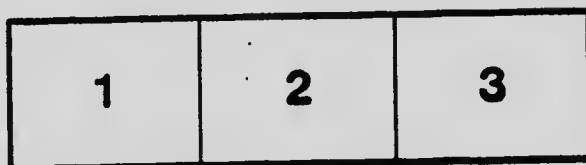
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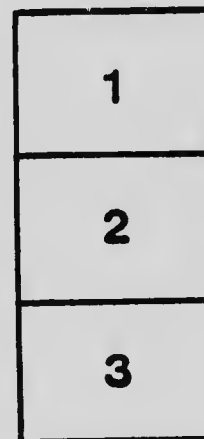
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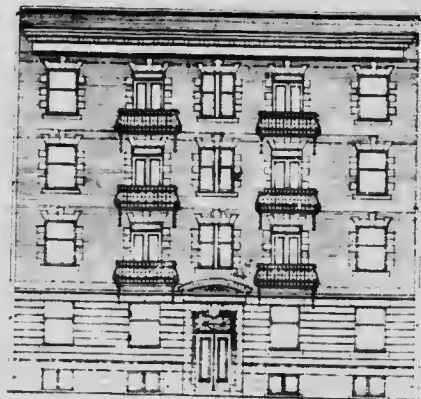


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Après quelques années d'étude dans cette institution il se consacra à l'optique où il obtenait des degrés avec grande distinction il y a un an.
