The READING ROOM is open daily (Sunday's excepted) from two o'clock until 9.30 o'clock, p. m. Leading newspapers and standard publications on file.

The SCHOOL OF DESIGN is open from 7 o'clock to 9 o'clock, p. m., for Free-hand, Architectural and Mechanical Drawing, with Landscape and Figure. LADIES' DRAWING CLASS, from 2.30 o'clock to 4.30 o'clock, p. m., for Pencil, Crayon, and Painting in Oil and Water Colors. Terms—\$2.00 per quarter to members; non-members \$3. per quarter.

The LIBRARY has been recently replenished, and is open daily (Sundays excepted) from 4.30 to 5.30, p. m. and every Monday and Friday Evening from 7 to 8 o'clock.

The MUSEUM is open every Monday Evening from 7 o'clock.

The initiation fee for members is Two DOLLARS, which, with the payment of an annual subscription of three Dollars, will entitle a member and two of his family to all the privileges of the Institute, including attending the Lectures, and the use of the Library, Museum and Reading Room when open.

✂ TICKETS FOR A SINGLE LECTURE WILL NOT BE ISSUED.

N. B.—In order to prevent unpleasantness and confusion at the door, the Directors have resolved to issue THREE TICKETS to each Member, which must invariably be shown to the Doorkeepers; and owing to the limited capacity of the Hall, the rule providing admission to the holders of those tickets only, must be rigidly enforced. Members have the right to introduce Non-Residents to any of the Lectures—the name of the person introduced and of the Member introducing him being written on a card and handed to the Doorkeeper.

✂ Boys unaccompanied by their parents or guardians will not be admitted to the gallery.

Tickets, Programmes of the Concert and Course of Lectures, and all information concerning the Institute may be obtained from the Curator at the Institute from 4 to 6 o'clock daily (Sunday excepted).

✂ Doors opened at 7 o'clock on Lecture evenings.
