GOVERNOR OF INDIANA

Hopes to settle street-car strike by arbitration.

Troops will remain in quarters until strike is settled.

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., Nov. 7.—Indiana troops will not be placed under martial law and the entire State militia, that was brought here yesterday for strike duty, will remain in its present quarters as long as there is a possibility of settling the street-car strike. This announcement was made by Governor Shallenbarger after a conference with both sides to the controversy early today.

"I am very hopeful of having this trouble settled by arbitration," said the Governor, "and as long as there is a possibility of bringing this about I shall not place the troops in control of the city."

The Governor yesterday and last night was trying to bring about a settlement of the strike through the Public Utilities Commission, which is acting as an intermediary.

The recognition of the union seemed to be the bone of contention between the strikers and street car company.

Everything was quiet on the streets this morning and there was no demonstration of any consequence made against the troops during the night.

Robert L. Todd, president of the Transportation Company, said an effort would be made to start the cars until the Governor gave the word.

HUERTA MAY RETIRE

If the Powers support action of United States.

BURLINGAME, Nov. 7.—The correspondent of the Frankfort Gazette in Mexico City telegraphs today that he has the impression that General Huerta may perhaps retire from office as provisional President if the great Powers support the action of the United States, as by doing he will avoid the appearance of fleeing in the face of a pressure alone.

The correspondent mentions a plan of the Provisional President to recall the Mexican minister to recall the United States minister to assume the provisional presidency.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 7.—The cabinet met today for the first time in several weeks. All the secretaries except Garrison and Wilson and Attorney General Clegg were present.

It was understood that at the instance of the President, one or two members who had planned to resign were recalled to attend the meeting, and Secretary Bryan carried a large envelope of State Department despatches.
