

Mrs Gardner presented hersaelf at the polls with a vase of flowers and also a prepared ballot, which she had decorated with various appropriate devices, in her hands. The inspector asked the questions in regard to name and residence put to all applicants, and her name being found duly registered her ballot was received and deposited in the box without any further proceedings whatever. 
