The population given in this Index is from the United States Census Reports of 1900, excepting for towns in the Northwest Territories.

**NOTE**—The population of Alaska, as given in the census reports, is necessarily largely an estimate. What census taker would be willing to go a couple of thousand miles up the Yukon, for instance, to find the number of miners in one of the new camps, or venture into the Arctic Circle to count the Esquimos? Dogs furnish a great part of all the means of transportation and communication up there in the snows, and they are not valuable for census work.
