To Test Legality Urged by American Newspaper Publishers' Ass'n.

New York, Feb. 18.—At a meeting of the American Newspaper Publishers' Association today, the famine in white paper was discussed and the following resolution, introduced by Conde Hamlin of the St. Paul Pioneer Press, was unanimously adopted:

That the American Newspaper Publishers' Association request the President of the United States and the Attorney-General to institute a suit against any paper combinations to test the legality of their existence and whether they do not stifle competition.
