# REPORT

OF THE

Primitive Methodist Missionary Society,

CANADA,

FOR THE YEAR ENDING APRIL 30TH, 1858.

—o—

THE recent "panic" and "hard times" are phrases which have become pretty familiar to us lately ; and as *retrenchment* is another term consequent on the former, we advisedly carry out its import in this preface, to harmonize with our printing expenses. A long introduction this year will be the less necessary, as we purpose to establish a newspaper, the "Christian Journal," which will give frequent carefully-selected communications about our Missions ; and we expect all our members and friends will take a copy of the paper. Real facts are much more acceptable than any eloquent description on Missionary matters. We trust our Missionary supporters will in future have such facts and incidents as they have a right to receive, as contributors to the work of God : to know, in detail, all in relation to such work. This anticipated course of things will, it is expected, operate favorably in reference to the Missionaries themselves, as well as the friends in general, inducing a more searching scrutiny into their labours,—training to habits of literary and useful correspondence. During the past year the Missionary Secretary has importuned the Brethren to send frequent extracts from their Journals, that he might make use of them in Canada, as well as transmit portions for the Missionary Notices published in England ; but he regrets he has received a very small amount of what he repeatedly solicited. The publishing of the "Christian Journal" will, however, bring the matter fully to bear : unless *each* Missionary sends regular notices of his success, etc., the interests of the newspaper will never be sustained : with fre-

quent, *short*, pointed, and original facts, which will lay hold on the sympathies of the people, the "Christian Journal" will be a happy arrangement for the promotion of God's glory, and the instruction and salvation of fallen men.

Being sanguine that the "Christian Journal" will keep continually before our friends the progress of the Mission work, an elaborate Annual Statement will now be declined, and a few brief notices given of each Station consecutively :

**KINGSTON.**—This Mission has not increased its numbers during the year ; yet the prospects for the future are by no means discouraging. The late Conference, believing it would accord more with the spirit of Primitive Methodist enterprise to blend this Mission with the Bath Road Station, and thus give the Missionaries an opportunity to take up several new places, where their services might be of advantage to many ungathered by other Churches.

**PORTLAND.**—This Mission is extensive, and throws its efforts on several points really needed. The Brethren have laboured, and have had seals to their Ministry. The Mission receipts, both annual and quarterly, have increased : disciplinary matters have been judiciously attended to ; and the Committee and Conference have been satisfied with the reports from time to time. May the future be more happy and prosperous than even the past.

**NAPANEE.**—This Mission has been stationary, but we hope there are no symptoms of decay. The Missionary had a long illness in the summer months, which probably had its influence ; but the Missionary Committee promptly attended to the Mission, in obtaining a substitute, consequently there was no interruption in the preaching appointments. The Committee hope, that with the spirit of faith and confidence with which the newly appointed Brother enters on his charge, the revival work will spread through the entire Mission.

**OSPREY.**—The supporters of Missions are assured, that if any locality requires their support and sympathy, this is one of the number. This country is new ; evangelical services are scarce, and the settlers very poor, utterly without the means, at present, to

support the services of religion. This is, therefore real Mission ground. As a Missionary with a family is now appointed, who will want a place in which to lay their heads, and food and raiment, (not being angels, to dispense with these things,) it is hoped our Missionary contributors will be urged to greater efforts in view of the necessities of this and other kindred Stations under our care.

**GALT AND BLENHEIM.**—Here we have had adversity and trouble. The Missionaries have laboured faithfully ; but counter influences have been at work, and several defections have taken place. The smallness of the receipts, and the heavy drain on the Mission Fund, induced the Conference to appoint one Missionary only, reserving a portion of the means for other localities where the gospel is more intensely needed, and the probability of saving sinners more likely to be realized.

**GUELPH.**—The country appointments of this Mission are very slender, and afford little support to a Missionary. The "peculiar" character of the Town Chapel has for years discouraged Missionaries of all temperaments ! The Conference has given directions for selling the old Chapel, and commencing in a new locality, where the work may have a fresh start, in this rising town and neighbourhood.

**ORANGEVILLE.**—The "hard times" have been peculiarly felt among the friends forming the Membership of this Mission. And, taking every matter into consideration, this Mission has struggled with energy : many difficulties have been combatted, and privations borne. The Missionary has had a large amount of toil to endure, and labours to perform not strictly within the province of his function ; but there have been souls saved, and the Mission has been sustained, with an increase of members for the connexional year.

**PEEL AND WELLESLEY.**—Here a small increase is reported ; but the receipts, quarterly and annually, have declined, which is a matter of regret, as old Stations are expected, in a few years, to be SELF-SUSTAINING, that the Mission funds may be relieved, in order that the distant fields of the moral waste in Canada may be cultivated.

LONDON.—This extensive Station reports an increase ; and probably more prosperous results would have been achieved, had it not been for the severe accident which befell Brother William Rowe, which for some months suspended his labours. We hope now, as God has restored him, the Mission will flourish, and the contemplated new Chapel in London be a reality. It is exceedingly desirable that in the neighbourhood of this Mission, in the direction of St. Marys, McGillivray, etc., there should be efforts directed. We hope, ere long, to have the means to enter into those fields whitening to the harvest.

BRANTFORD AND PARIS.—The new Chapels erected on this Mission, we trust, are now beginning to tell on the importance of this field of labour, in relation to congregations, and receipts to *sustain* the gospel. The general work, which requires regularly prosecuting, will, we trust, advance in town and country. Two fresh Missionaries are about to enter on this part of our Canadian work. May they have many souls, and great joy in their glorious toil.

BRANT AND DURHAM.—We regret that this Mission, so necessary to be sustained in a comparatively new country, should have been crippled, through the year, by a want of cordial co-operation, internally : the Missionary, also, having changed his doctrinal opinions, and gone elsewhere. The Station is now supplied with a *trustworthy* Missionary, who will enter into the work with his usual earnestness ; and, with the promised blessing of God, we shall expect a revival.

WALSINGHAM.—This Mission has advanced during the year, and a blessed work of God has gone on, and prospered the Societies. The Missionary in charge of Walsingham Mission furnished an interesting account of the work, which was published in the British Missionary Notices, and also in the Primitive Methodist Large Magazine, for April, 1858.

BOSANQUET.—This is another Mission Station in our connexional range where our operations are needed, and where the friends of Missions may expend their offerings acceptably to God, for the salvation of souls. Here an extensive section of country is opened for

the gospel of the grace of God ; and the friends of Missions and of man, looking around on the openings in destitute settlements, and feeling anxious that the word of God should be abundantly preached to every creature, have agreed to enter on the work with redoubled energy ; but the question comes home upon them, where are the men and means to enable them to carry out their high and holy resolves ? The revulsion in trade and commerce has had an effect in diminishing the ordinary revenue ; and to enter on fresh engagements with wasted resources would be injudicious.

In view of this aspect of things, the late Conference decided to send a deputation of two Brethren to England, to request leave of the British Conference to lay before the Primitive Methodist people the wants and claims of Canada ; and solicit help from the wealthy, and from those who may be disposed to encourage Missions in this country. The Deputation are expected to send accounts of their journeys and labours in Britain, in furtherance of this object, which will be published in the " Christian Journal," to which newspaper reference has been made. And as the first Friday evening in each month has been selected by the Conference for all the Societies to hold a *special* prayer-meeting for the success of the Deputation, and the conversion of the world, we trust God will give us, along with other Christian people, the desires of our hearts, that not only Canada, in its noble territory, may be overspread with the glorious light of truth, but that the whole world may be speedily filled with the brightness of Jehovah's glory. Amen.
