




"BUTEN. - Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land to be taken a situate of if the homestander dowines he may, on applications to the Minister of the Interve. Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration. Winnipeg, or the local agent for the district in which the land is situate receive authority for some one to make entry for him. A fee of iso is charged for an ordinary homestad entry.


HOMESTEAD DUTIES .- Under the present law homestead duties must be performed in one of the fol-

APPLICATION FOR PATENT should be made at the end of three years before the Local Agent, Sub-Agent, or the Homestead Inspector. Before making application for patent the settler must give six months notice in writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of his intention to do so.




