Ottawa Firemen's Benevolent Association

On Monday, April 5th, 1875, the Ottawa Fire Department, called the General Meeting, to meet him at his office for the purpose of organizing a Firemen's Benevolent Association. At this meeting a Committee was appointed to draft a Constitution and By-laws.

On April 9th, 1875, a special meeting was called for the purpose of receiving the report of the Committee on Constitution and By-laws. Those present were Chief Young, Deputy Chief Paul Favreau, Guardian Mills, No. 1 Station, Guardian Stanford, No. 2 Station, Guardian Frank Graham, No. 3 Station, Guardian Wm. Welch, No. 4 Station, and Joseph Smith, representing the Conquerer Engine Company.

Chief Young was appointed Chairman.

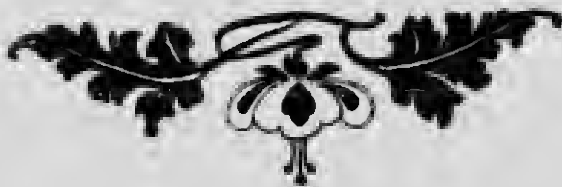
After reading the Constitution and By-laws, it was moved by Guardian Frank Graham, seconded by Guardian Thomas Stanford, that the Fire Department of the City of Ottawa form themselves into a Benevolent Association.—Carried unanimously.

TITLE AND OBJECT.

This Society shall be called The Ottawa Firemen's Benevolent Association, and has for its object the relief of members who may be injured while engaged in their duties as firemen; and also to afford aid to the widows and orphans of firemen, whose death may be caused by accident or sickness contracted while in the discharge of their duties.

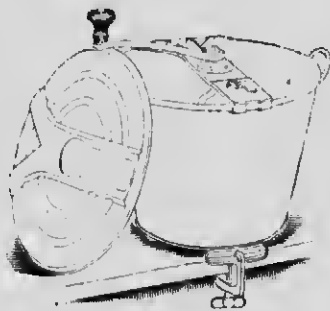

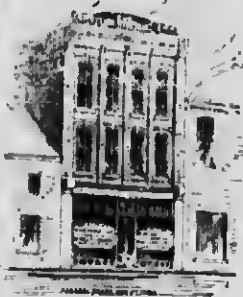

Brief History of C. F. D

A paid Fire Department was instituted in 1874, with Mr. Wm. Young as Chief, and Paul Favreau as Deputy. The personnel of the Brigade consisted of 18 officers and men, with five Fire Stations. The equipment of the Department was one Fire Engine and four 1-horse Hose reels and one Hook and Ladder truck.

In 1887 the Department was considerably increased, Rideau Ward, New Edinburgh as it was then called, was annexed to the City, and a new Fire Station built and equipped with four men and a 1 horse hose reel.

A new central Fire Station was built in rear of the City Hall, and equipped with Langevin Extension Ladder, 1-horse Hose reel and six men; also, one man added to each of the other Stations.

In 1890 Rochesterville was annexed to the City and a new Fire Station built, and four men and 1-horse Hose reel placed there. This brought the strength of the Department up to 36 officers and men, one Engine, one Extension Ladder, one Hook and Ladder truck, and seven Hose reels, carrying 500 feet of hose each.

During the winter of 1896 and 1897—after a series of disastrous fires such as Ross' block, Sparks street, and West Block, Government Building, public opinion was that equipment was out of date, and that reorganization was necessary.

The City Council voted \$50,000 and appointed a Special Committee to reorganize the Department and purchase the latest fire fighting apparatus. The result was that Capt. Prevost of Montreal Fire Department was appointed Chief, and given complete control.

And Ottawa today can boast of having the finest and up to date Department in Canada.

The personnel of our Brigade consists of 54 officers and men, 9 well equipped Fire Stations, 9 Hose waggons and sleighs, 35 Horses, 2 Aerial trucks, 2 Segrave Hook and Ladder trucks, and 3 Steam Fire Engines and 2 Coal tenders.

Chairman of the Fire and Light Committee.

Alderman C. S. O. Boudreault is now Chairman of the Fire and Light Committee. This is his second year in connection with the Fire Department. Alderman Boudreault takes a keen interest in the Brigade, and his friends expect, under his stewardship, the Brigade will continue to progress in the same ratio it did when under the superintendence of ex-Chairman Hasteley, one of the best aldermen who ever sat at the City Council.

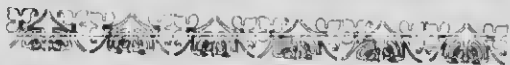

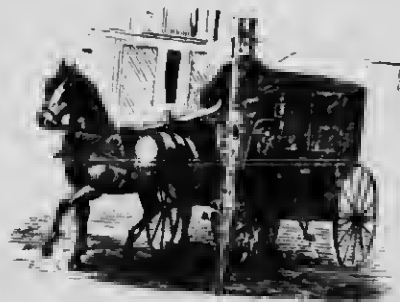
