FUNDAMENTAL LAWS.

I. That every Military Officer who wishes to join the Institution, on the payment of one day's pay of his actual rank, at the time, each year for three years, on entrance, and an Annual Subscription of Six Dollars, payable on the 1st January and 1st July, shall be entitled permanently to all the advantages of this Institution. Any subscriber who wishes to join the Institution before the termination of the half year, shall pay at the usual rate of Two Shillings and Six Pence per month, instead of the usual half-yearly Subscription of Three Dollars, until the termination of the half year, commencing from the first of each month. This Institution shall also be open to the admission of Officers of the Navy, and to Officers of the Naval and Military Departments, and Widows of Officers resident in the Garrison, subscribing as above; the Institution being restricted to Officers holding His Majesty's Commission; but persons serving His Majesty in the several Departments of the Navy and Army, in situations on equal footing with Commissioned Officers, shall, under the following restrictions, be competent to belong to the Institution, viz:—They shall only be considered Members so long as they actually hold such situations, and shall be elected by ballot, agreeably to the 11th Fundamental Law.

II. That no Subscriber shall have power to transfer, by sale or gift, his share in the Library. That all Members resident in the Garrison, whose half yearly subscriptions remain unpaid for fourteen days after the first January, and first July respectively, shall incur a penalty of One Dollar in addition to their half yearly subscription, and they are not

to receive any Books from the Library until the above penalty and subscription are paid :—but as most of the original subscribers may be called away, by duty or otherwise, from the Garrison, and be absent a considerable time, such Subscribers, whenever they may return, are to be entitled to the same privileges, as if they had been constant residents, provided, at their return, they conform to whatever Rules the Society may be then governed by ; and if at their departure, they shall have paid their half-yearly subscription in advance, they are to resume their rights, as Subscribers, without further payment from the day of their return to the ensuing day of Subscription.

III. That the names of the original and all future Subscribers, shall be entered in a Book to be kept for that purpose ; and in a proper Register shall be enrolled the names of those benefactors, who by contributions of money or books, have encouraged, or may hereafter support this design, which register shall be placed in a conspicuous part of the Library Room.

IV. That the Committee shall be summoned to meet the first Thursday of every month, in the Library Room, or at any other place they shall appoint, to transact the business of the Society. Any three of them, of which the Treasurer, Librarian, or Secretary, shall be one, shall be deemed competent to act, if no more be assembled ; and the Proceedings of the Committee, so far as is found useful and necessary shall be recorded by the Member presiding, in a Book kept for that purpose.

V. That a General Meeting of the Subscribers shall be held every Twelve Months, on the second Tuesday in January, at which time, the Committee for the ensuing twelve months is to be appointed, and the old Committee are to give over their accounts and funds to the newly elected Members.

VI. No Fundamental Laws shall be suspended, repealed, or annulled, nor a new one carried into force, without being approved by the majority of a General Meeting, summoned by the Committee for that express purpose ; the question being made public in the Library Room, eight days before the Meeting.

VII. That any Subscriber may propose what Books he pleases, by writing their titles in a memorandum book, to be kept by the Sub-Librarian, which is to be laid before the

Committee, at every Monthly Meeting, that they may vote in, or reject the Books proposed, as the nature of the scheme and the funds to support it, naturally require; and that no Books be voted in but such as have been proposed at a prior meeting.

VIII. That every Subscriber, at the time of paying his first subscription, shall receive a ticket, which must always be ready to be shewn to the Sub-Librarian, if required, when a Book is sent for, to prevent mistakes or impositions; and if any book be lost or defaced, the person in whose hands it was, or ought to have been, shall pay the original value of the Books, or of the set, if it belongs to one, under the penalty of being excluded the Society:—The Sub-Librarian to examine minutely each Book as it is returned, and if defaced or injured, to let the person returning the book know of the injury before 12 o'clock, next day.

IX. That every Subscriber shall have liberty to introduce a stranger to the Library Room; but no Book shall be delivered out of the Room to any person except subscribers. The time of keeping a book in hand, shall be fixed by the Librarian, and written on the inside of the cover; and if any Subscriber shall keep a Book longer than the period allowed, he shall forfeit a sum for every day that he exceeds, as may be determined by the private regulations of the Society. Residents who are eligible to become Subscribers, but declining it are not to have the benefit of this Rule.

X. That whenever Forfeitures shall be fixed by the Committee, the offender shall be denied any more Books, until such forfeit has been paid.

XI. Half-Pay Officers of the Navy or Army, or such as may have sold out of the Army, residents in the Province, may be admitted as Honorary Members, paying on admission, *Three days' full pay* of the rank they at present hold, or may have retired from, and the Annual subscription of Six Dollars, having previously been balloted for by a Committee of not less than nine members; to be excluded by five black balls, if balloted by a full Committee, or by three black balls if by a lesser number.

XII. Honorary Members shall not be eligible to sit in the Committee of Management.

XIII. That no Member be allowed to transfer Books to another Subscriber without incurring a penalty of Ten Shillings.

XIV. That a Subscriber lending a Book to a non-subscriber shall incur a penalty of Ten Dollars for the first offence, and expulsion for the second.

BYE LAWS.

I. No Book of general reference is to be taken out of the Library Room during reading hours, and the Committee will determine what Books come under that description.

II. The number of days limited by the Committee for the perusal of each Book, and also the forfeit for retaining it beyond that time, shall be written on the inside of the Boards; and no Subscriber shall have another book delivered to him until he has paid for the time exceeded. The forfeits are established at the following rates for each day's detention of the book beyond the time fixed; and they must be paid when the book is returned.

A Folio or Quarto.....6d.

An Octavo or Duodecimo...5d.

A Pamphlet.....2d.

The time specified within the cover is to comprise a clear number of days, besides the one on which the Book is delivered; to be returned by twelve o'clock, on the day following the expiration of the allotted time; Sunday not being included in the number of days allotted for reading.

III. In order that the above regulation may not lead Subscribers into unintentional expences on account of forfeitures they may be subject to pay from neglecting to return a book in due time, through duty, absence, or any involuntary mistake, notice shall be given by the Sub-Librarian to each Subscriber, when one day's forfeiture is due upon the book in his hand; he may then renew the time in the book, unless it should be wanted, in which case it must be returned, with one day's forfeit. If any one refuses to comply with these terms, he shall be liable to the fines daily increasing, and the circumstance laid before the Committee at the next Monthly Meeting.

IV. That whoever applies to the Sub-Librarian first for a Book, shall have it, and the rest in order as they make

application ; but if two or more apply at the same time for one and the same book, the preference shall be determined by lot. Whenever any person applies for a Book that is engaged, the Sub-Librarian must let him know when it will be at liberty. If he does not come, or send for it the day it returns to the Library, the Sub-Librarian may let any other person have it.

V. That if any Book is presented to the Sub-Librarian, torn or defaced (by drawing or writing upon it,) or otherwise materially injured, he is to refuse delivering another Book to that Subscriber, until he has complied with the terms of the 8th Fundamental Law.

VI. If any Subscriber shall designedly tear, or pull off, the paper cover of a Library Book, that Subscriber shall forfeit and pay One Shilling ; and the offender be denied any more Books, until the forfeiture is paid.

VII. The forfeitures shall be received by the Sub-Librarian, and paid by him into the hands of the Treasurer.

VIII. All Pamphlets and Periodicals shall be considered as books of reference, during the first month after their arrival, and consequently be allowed to go out between the hours of six in the afternoon, and half-past ten the next morning. The usual fine of Two Shillings and Six Pence being exacted in case of their not being returned at the proper time. The Governor or Lieutenant Governor having the privilege of taking out Books without reference to this Bye Law.

IX. Servants coming for Books are not to enter the room, but to remain at the door until they receive an answer.

X. The President may call a Meeting extraordinary, whenever circumstances may require.

XI. The ladies of families of Subscribers are allowed to subscribe, and are entitled, separately, to all the privileges of Subscribers, upon paying one half yearly Subscription, and observing the rules and laws of the Society, without being required to pay original deposit.

XII. The Newspapers are to be laid on the Library Table for one fortnight after their arrival, at the expiration of which time, they are to be filed, in order that the Subscribers may be enabled to refer to them ; and they are not to be taken out of the Room during the reading hours.

XIII. The Admiral, Captains, and Ward Room Officers of the Squadron on this Station, shall have free admission to the Library, to peruse any of the Books during the hours the Rooms are open.

XIV. A Subscriber is permitted to have out of the Library, for his own use, either two volumes of one work, or one volume of two separate works, it being the intention of the Committee, that more than two volumes should not, at one time be in a subscriber's possession, except when, on a special application, their consent shall have been obtained, or in the case hereafter specified; but one number of a Review, Magazine, or other Periodical Work or Pamphlet may be issued in addition to the two volumes before mentioned, as also any Maps, &c. bound separate from the work to which they belong.—In this latter case, should more than one Subscriber be reading the same work, the Maps may be retained throughout by the person who first began it. Magazines, Pamphlets, &c. when bound up to be considered as a volume.

The whole of a Novel, in any language, is to be issued at once, without affecting the Subscriber's right to one volume of another work; but no Subscriber can be allowed to take out two sets of Novels at one time, or to return a part and retain the remainder of the set in his hands.

XV. Any Member who shall take any Book, Pamphlet, or Newspaper out of the Library, contrary to the regulations, shall be subject to a fine of Twenty Shillings for the first offence, and in case of a repetition shall be expelled from the Society, and his name inserted in the Records of the Library.

XVI. With reference to No. XI. of the Fundamental Laws, the name of any Candidate for admission to the Library, as a Subscriber, is to be exhibited in the Room for at least ten days before the meeting of any Committee by which he is to be ballotted: his name being supported by that of the Subscriber proposing him, and seconded by another.

XVII. The Library to be open every day except Sunday; the hours to be regulated from time to time at the Monthly Meeting of the Committee.

XXVIII. The Officiating Chaplains, for the time being, to the Garrison and Naval Establishments, to be admitted as Honorary Members without subscription.

XIX. All propositions, that are brought forward before the Committee, are to be decided upon the next Meeting.

XX. All Books to be returned into the Library on the first day of June, and first day of December, in each year, for the inspection of the Librarian:

XXI. Subscribers that send their servants or orderlies to the Library either with or for Books, are required to furnish them with a box or bag, in which the books are to be deposited, that they may not be injured by dirt or wet.
