Hawarden, May 19.—Gladstone is dead. He died at five o'clock this morning.

All last night a weary vigil was maintained. The whole family was in and out of the sick room.

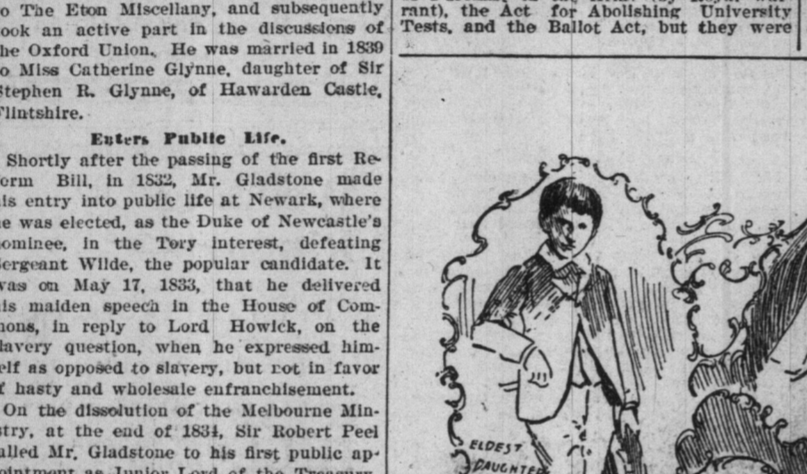

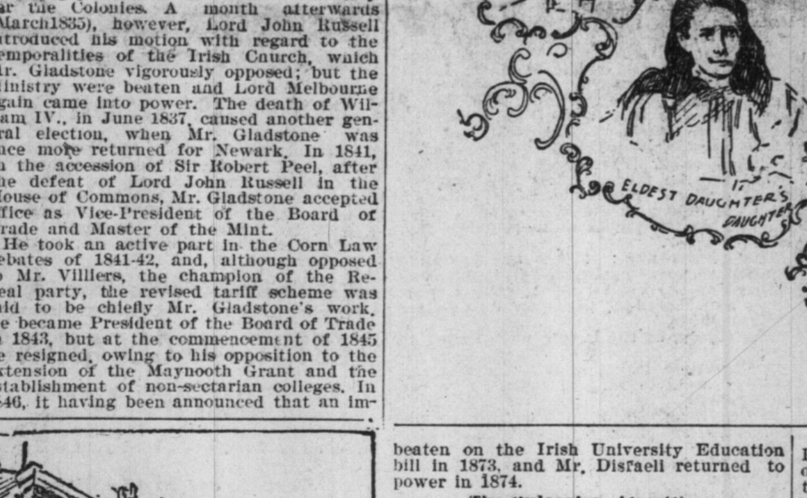

Ottawa, May 18.—(Special.)—There is to be another Yukon Railway deal with Mackenzie and Mann, and details may be looked for on Friday.

When the Liberal caucus met some days ago, there was a strong outbreak against any further Yukon deals from Mr. Sifton, but before the meeting closed it was agreed to give the Government a free hand.

The new deal is a much larger one, viz., for an all-Canadian road from a point on the Pacific coast in British Columbia to Teslin Lake, via Glenora.

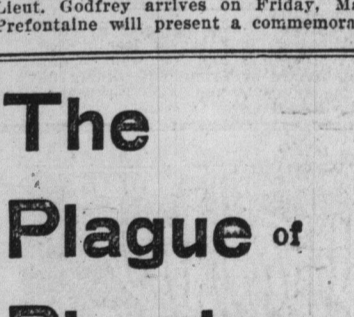
