A perceptible rise in bank rates of interest is now on hand over the border, and without doubt the change will make itself felt in Canada.

The other day the New York bank statement for last week made a surprise on commercial circles. That statement showed that a third of the surplus held on July 31 had vanished in one week.

The New York Tribune in its weekly review during the fall on the supply of money, with over \$50,000,000 in circulation, the fact that the market continued easy through the crop-moving period, but since that time over \$75,000,000 paper circulation has been retired or taken in by the treasury, and the bank surplus shown by last week's report was only \$2,000,000.
