## DRAFT EXEMPTIONS

How the U.S. Government Will Choose the First Contingent from the $10,000,000$ Men Who Registered
The fact that practically ten million men of military age registeredin one day in the United States is, in the opinion of American newspapers, this country's conclusive answer to all efforts to convince the German people that this is "Wilson's War" and that it is without popular support or approval in
