An Act for grauting to Her Majesty certain sums of money required for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government for the finaucial year ending thirtieth June, 1866, and for other purposes connected with the Public Service.

Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by messages from His Excellency freambe. the Right Honorable Charles Stanley, Viscount Monck, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of Canada,
5 and the estimates accompanying the same, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray centain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province not otherwise provided for, for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, and other putposes
10 connected with the public service: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada. that,- :

15 1. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province, there shall and may be paid and applied, a sum not exceeding in the whole five million, six thousand, one hundred and forty-five dollars, and two cents, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Province,
20 for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in the Schedule to this Act, and for the other purposes therein mentioned.
2. The amount of such sums of money as may have been 25 paid during the first quarter of the present financial year, for or on account of any of the services mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, out of the sum of two million dollars granted for such services by the Act passed in the' now last session of the $\begin{gathered}\text { Granted } \\ \text { be }\end{gathered}$ Provincial Parliament, chapter three, shall be charged as having
30 been paid out of the sums granted for such services by this Act, and the balance of the said grant of two million dollars after deducting the amount expended up to thirtieth June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, as detailed in a statement laid before the Legislative Assembly, viz: one million six
hundred and sixty-three thousand five hundred and sixty-seven dollars and twenty-four cents, shall be cancelled and returned to the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Loan of $\$ 1,000$. 000 authoriz 3. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to authorize on credtit of the raising, by way of loan, on the credit of the Consolidated Con. Hev. Revenuc Fund of this Province, of a sum not exceeding one milFund. lion dollars, to be placed to the credit of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund, towards making good the sums charged on the said Fund by this Act, for the Public Service.
