

BILL.

An Act to prevent the Seizure and Sale of the Homestead in satisfaction of Debt, in certain cases and upon certain conditions.

HEREAS it is in accordance with humanity and Presmble, sound policy to exempt the homestead of the debtor from seizure and sale, provided the value of such homestead do not exceed a certain sum :- Be it therefore en-5 acted. &c.

That in addition to the property exempt by law from sale Certain real under execution, there shall be exempt from such sale for estate exemptdebts contracted after this Act shall take effect, real estate and sale. not exceeding in value two hundred and fifty pounds,

10 owned by the debtor, being a householder and having a family.

II. And be it enacted, That to entitle a debtor to the Description benefit of such exemption, a description of the property and notice to be given to the claimed to be exempt, with a notice of such claim, exe-seizing officer.

- Canada signed by the debtor and proved or acknowledged as deeds are required by law to be proved or ac-knowledged to entitle them to be registered, shall be delivered to the officer having such execution in his hands

And be it enacted, That in case such real estate shall be bought, not by or in behalf of the debtor, the 20 debtor it may officer making such sale shall state in the certificate thereof, in addition to what is now required to be stated therein, that the real estate so sold may be redeemed by or in behalf of the judgment debtor, or the widow, heirs or devisees of such debtor, within one year from the time 25 of such sale, on payment to the purchaser, his personal representatives or assigns, or to the officer who made such sale, for the use of such purchaser, of the excess bid on such sale over two hundred and fifty pounds, with the interest on such excess from the time of such sale, 30 at the rate of ten per cent. a year, and such redemption may be made by or in behalf of the debtor, or the widow, heirs or devisees of such debtor accordingly; and upon such redemption being made the sale of such real estate and the certificate of such sale shall be null and void. 35

And be it enacted, That the sum required to be cess over £250 paid by the purchaser at the time of a sale, in pursuance but no more of the last section, shall be the excess only which shall be bid for the premises over two hundred and fifty pounds, and such sum shall be applied first to discharge the fees 40 and expenses of such sale, and the residue in reduction, or so far as may be necessary in satisfaction of the amount due on the execution.

VII. And be it enacted, That no deed shall be executed by the officer making such sale, to the purchaser nor to 45 til he has paid any person who may have acquired the rights of such the £250 for purchaser, in the manner provided by law or otherwise, until the sum of two hundred and fifty pounds shall be paid to such officer by the person demanding the deed, for the use of the judgment debtor; and in case the same 50 shall not be paid within eighteen months from the time

of the sale, the certificate given in pursuance thereof, shall be null and void.

VIII. And be it enacted, That the officer receiving The £250 to be such sum shall pay the same to the judgment debtor, paid to the debtor, and ex-5 and the same and any securities which shall be taken cmpt from seitherefor and any income thereof, shall not be liable to ture for a cerbe taken for any debt of such judgment debtor within one year from the time when the same shall be paid to such debtor.

And be it enacted, That the crops which may be Crops, rents, raised upon, and the rents, issues and profits which may &c. of exbe derived from the real estate claimed to be exempt be also exempt from execution in pursuance of this Act, shall not be liable on certain conto be taken to satisfy any debt of such judgment debtor,

15 within one year from the time when such crops may he secured from the land, or the rents, issues or profits may be received by the debtor; provided a description of the real estate and notice of such claim shall be received, as provided in the third section of this Act,

20 before such crops shall be secured, or such rents, issues or profits received by the debtor.

X. And be it enacted, That this Act shall have force Commencement of Act. and effect upon, from and after the first day of one thousand eight hundred and fifty and not 25 before.
