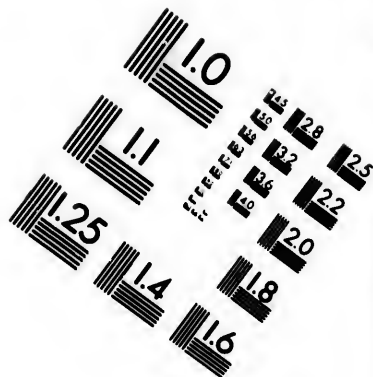




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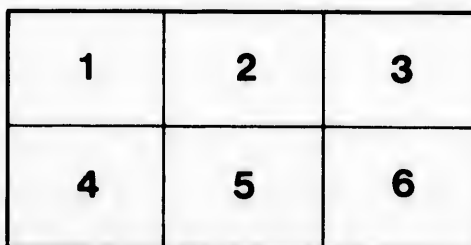
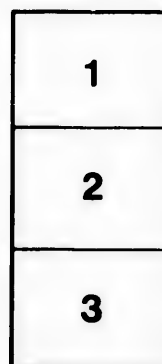

EVENTS.

1. SCURRY RACE—200 yards barebacked, numnah allowed, but no sureingle; competitors are to mount when the flag falls, turn a post at half distance; one jump, each way, 2 feet high; post to be kept on right hand.
2. TUG OF WAR—for teams of men belonging to H. M. Services; 10 men per team; boots allowed, no spikes, no holes, coaching allowed.
3. TANDEM RACE—One horse to be ridden and the other driven, with reins only; no traces; distance, once round the course.
4. HURDLE RACE—foot; 120 yards; 10 flights; hurdles 3 feet high.
5. CIGAR AND UMBRELLA RACE—Ladies' nomination. Horses to be bridled. Each competitor to stand by his horse's head with saddle on his arm. When the flag falls he is to saddle up, light a cigar, open an ordinary umbrella, mount, ride to a point 100 yards distant, dismount, open a bottle of soda water and drink its contents, mount and ride back to starting point over a two foot fence. Any competitor who does not ride in with his cigar alight, or who has not kept his umbrella open during the race, will be disqualified.
6. MENAGERIE RACE—50 yards. No dogs, horses, mules, donkeys or cows allowed. Animals to be driven with a string, not led. Any competitor getting in front of his animal will be disqualified. A whip or stick allowed.
7. FOOT RACE—half mile, flat. Competitors over 30 years of age allowed a start of 5 yards for each year over 30.
8. SCREEN RACE—100 yards. At 30 yards from starting point a two foot fence to be taken; at 70 yards a paper screen to be gone through; the screen must be broken by the horse and not by the rider; no backing through the screen allowed.
No limit to size of horses; horses to be entered by their riders.
Post entries, \$1.50.
Tent pegging and lemon cutting if there be sufficient time.
The decision of the Judges to be absolutely final.

Prizes in all events to be sweeps, except in the foot races, in the Lady's Nomination Race, to which \$20 will be added, and in the Tug of War, in which the prize will be \$20.

The "Assembly" will be sounded by a bugler five minutes before the start of each race.
