An Act to amend Chapter three of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada.

WHEREAS in order further to secure the independence of Parlia-Preamble. ment it is expedient to make further provision respecting the eligibility of persons to serve as members thereof, and to define the terms and conditions upon which persons elected to serve as members 5 of the Legislative Council, or Legislative Assembly, and holding any of the offices hereinafter mentioned, may resign such office and re-accept the same or any other office, without being thereby disqualified from sitting and voting in either of the said Houses.

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the 10 Legislative Council, and Legislative Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. No person whosoever then holding or enjoying, undertaking, or Persons havexecuting directly or indirectly, either alone or with any other person, ing contracts by himself or by the interposition of any Trustee or third party, any sidized Rail-15 Contract or agreement with any one of the Railway Companies incor-way Comporated by the Legislature of this Province, and to which any amount panies not to of the public monies thereof may have been advanced or loaned, or to sit in Parliawhich the credit of the Province may have been pledged, or in any way engaged, shall be eligible as a member of the said Legislative 20 Council, or Legislative Assembly, nor shall he sit or vote in either House; and if any person hereby disqualified shall nevertheless be elected and returned as a member of either House in the present or any future Parliament, such election and return shall be null and void, Penalty. and the person so elected shall be liable to the forfeiture, pains and 25 penalties set forth in the seventh section of the Act forming Chapter three of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada.

The fourth, fifth, seventh, eighth and ninth sections of the Act The said Act last mentioned shall apply as well to members of the Legislative and this Act Council appointed by the Crown as to Elective Members thereof, and non-elective 30 any provision therein to the contrary is hereby repealed; and members of if any member of the Legislative Council or Legislative Assem- the Legislably shall by accepting any office, or becoming interested in any way in tive Council. any contract or agreement as set forth in the fifth section of the said Act and in this Act, be disqualified under the provisions of either Act from 35 continuing to sit or vote in the said Legislative Council or Legislative Assembly, his seat shall thereby become vacant, and if he been Elective Member of the Legislative Council, or a Member of the Legislative Assembly, his election shall thereby become void, and a writ shall forthwith issue for a new election as if he were naturally dead; but he 40 may be re-elected a member of either House if he be eligible under section fourof the said Act.

As to resignation of a Ministerial office, and of appointment ta another within a month.

Proviso.

III. Whenever any person holding the office of Attorney General for Lower Canada, Attorney General for Upper Canada, Minister of Finance, Receiver General, Provincial Secretary, Commissioner of Crown Lands, Commissioner of Public Works, Speaker of the Legislative Council, President of Committees of the Executive Council, Minister of 5 Agriculture, Post Master General, Solicitor General for Lower Canada, or Solicitor General for Upper Canada, and being at the same time a Member of the Legislative Council or Legislative Assembly, shall resign such office, and within one month after his resignation accept the same or any other of the said offices, he shall not thereby vacate 10 his seat in the said Council or Assembly; Provided always that it shall not be competent to any more than four of the persons holding such offices to avail themselves of the provision herein, or in the said Act contained within the said period of one month, nor unless the four members so resigning within the same period of one month shall 15 reaccept office before the expiration of a month after the resignation of the first who shall have so resigned; And if any member of the said As to non- Legislative Council not subject to election and holding his seat for life, Elective Mem-shall accept any one of the said last mentioned offices, he shall thencebers of Legis-lativeCouncil tioned Act, and in this Act contained in like manner, and to the same
