The fine weather for the past two or three weeks has been taken advantage of by a number of private parties.

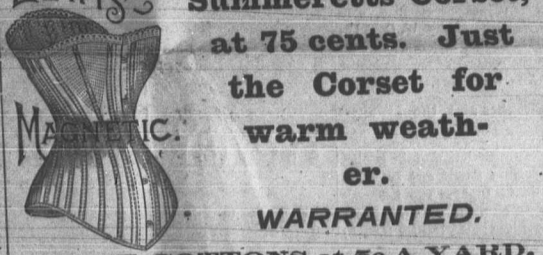
