PROGRAMME:

At 12 o'clock (noon), a Royal Salute will be fired, when the Indians will form a procession on the River in their canoes, passing round the men of war and landing on the New Road, whence they will proceed to the Cricket Ground.

At 12.30, Mrs. Seymour will present a set of Colours to the New Westminster Rifle Volunteers, on the Cricket Ground; after which the Governor will receive and address the Indian Chiefs.

At 2.25, there will be a succession of Indian Canoe Races, between the Camp and Herring's.

At 4 o'clock, athletic sports and games will take place on the Cricket Ground, as follows:—

1. Hurdle Race, 500 yards, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5.
2. Do. do. for Indians, suitable Prize.
3. Flat Race, 500 yards, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5.

3. Flat Race, 500 yards, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5.

5. Flat Race, 100 yards, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5.
6. Three legged Race, 500 yards, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5.
7. Do. do. for Indians, suitable Prize.
8. Highland Fling, in costume, Prize \$5.
9. Scotch Reel, Prize \$5.
10. Sack Race, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5.
11. Wheelbarrow Race, blindfold, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$2.50.
12. Pig in the Ring, 25 cents entrance, Prize a Pig.
13. Bobbing for Dumplings, Prize \$2.50.
14. Do. for Indians, Prize \$2.50.
15. Climbing Greasy Pole, Prize a Leg of Mutton.
16. Grinning through a horse collar, Prize \$2.50.
17. Standing high jump, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$2.50.
18. Running high jump 25 cents entrance, Prize \$2.50.
19. Standing jump, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$2.50.
20. Running jump, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$2.50.
21. Flying leap with pole, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$2.50.
22. Throwing the sledge, Prize \$2.50.
23. Tossing the cabar, Prize \$2.50.
24. Putting heavy stone, Prize \$2.50.
25. Barrel race, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$2.50.
26. Throwing cricket ball, Prize \$2.50.
27. Double race with riders, Prize \$2.50.
28. Aunt Sally, 25 cents for 6 sticks.
29. Cup and Ball, with whip in ring, blindfold, Prize \$1.
30. Gathering 50 stones, a yard apart, one to be carried at a time only, Prize \$2.50.
31. Smoking out of teapots for Indians, Prize \$1.

At 8 o'clock, Canoes and Boats wishing to join the torchlight procession will assemble at the Camp, where torches will be provided. The Leviathan will head the procession.

At 8.30, there will be a display of Fireworks on the River.

25TH MAY.

At 11 a.m., Horse Racing:— $\frac{1}{2}$ mile race, heats, \$1 entrance, Prize \$20; $\frac{1}{4}$ mile race, 50 cts. entrance, Prize \$10; 200 yards race, 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5.

At 2 p.m., Rifle Shooting at the Park Lane Butts:—A prize of \$5 to the best shot at 200 yds., 5 rounds, 25 cents entrance; Do., do., do., at 300 yds., 25 cents entrance, Prize \$5; with a variety of Sweepstakes to be arranged on the ground.

At 4 p.m., Boat and Canoe Races:—1. Four-oared Boats, entrance \$1, Prize \$15; 2. Three oars or a randan, Entrance \$1, Prize \$10; 3. Pair oars, entrance \$1, Prize \$7.50; 4. Canoe Race, Indians against white men, crew of 11, Prize \$11; 5. Canoes against Boats; number of oars and paddles to be arranged; 6. Canoe Race for white men, 2 paddles, Prize \$5.
