FORM OF BEQUEST.

To the Missionary Society of the Bible Christian Church in Canada.

I give and bequeath to the Treasurer or Treasurers, for the time being, of the Missionary Society of the Bible Christian Church in Canada, the sum of Dollars, out of such part of my personal Estate, as shall not consist of Mortgages, Chattels real, to be paid and expended by them under the direction of said Society, in aid and support of the Missionaries upon the different Mission Stations of said Society; and the Receipt or Receipts of such Treasurer or Treasurers, for the time being, shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors; and the published Minutes of the Conference of the Bible Christian Church in Canada shall be sufficient evidence of authority for the said Treasurer or Treasurers, upon which to demand and receive payment of said Bequest.

N. B.—Money may be given by will, provided it be directed to be paid out of the Personal Estate, as is set out in the form of Bequest.

ANNUAL MEETING.

The Anniversary of the Society was held on Sabbath and Monday, June 6th and 7th. On Sabbath, two sermons were preached : in the morning by Bro. R. T. Courtice, and in the evening by Bro. G. Webber. In the afternoon a Children's Missionary Meeting was held, and addresses were delivered by Bros. R. B. Rowe and J. F. Cummings. On Monday, the Missionary Services were resumed at 2.30 p.m., Bro. J. H. Eynon in the chair. After devotional exercises, the Secretary, Bro. R. T. Courtice, presented the Annual Report.

The first resolution :—

That the report, an abstract of which has been read, be adopted and printed under the direction of the Missionary Committee ; that we record heartiest thanks to our Collectors, and all who have aided in placing at the disposal of this Society, the contributions hereby acknowledged,

was moved by Bro. W. H. Butt ; seconded by Bro. J. Whitlock.

Shortly after the close of the afternoon service, tea was served in the basement of the Church, to a great crowd of people, numbering about 800 persons. The adjourned meeting commenced shortly after 7.30, with Bro. Barker in the chair. Bro. Kestle led in prayer.

The second resolution :—

That the establishment and extension of Christian Missions, in this age of restlessness and revolution ; should prompt the Church :
1. To a more regular and prayerful study of the Word of God. 2. To earnestly seek and humbly depend upon baptisms of the Holy Ghost for greater success. 3. To grateful and enlarged liberality in sustaining an institution whose walls are Salvation and whose gates are Praise,

was moved by Bro. E. Roberts and seconded by Bro. W. S. Pascoe.

The third resolution :—

That in view of the rapid settlement of Manitoba, and other North West Provinces and Territories, and the new settlers, (among whom are many of our own people), needing Gospel privileges. We resolve to enter such fields as Providence may direct, as fast as men and means can be obtained, and thus do our part in spreading Scriptural Holiness throughout those lands,

was moved by Bro. J. Greenway (from the North-West) and seconded by Bro. J. Harris.

Then followed an effort to make up the deficit on the North-West Mission for the last year, resulting in special contribution, amounting to \$189.

REPORT.

Life is made up of opportunities ; experience is the result of such circumstances in profit or loss. God gives life and opportunity ; experiences are largely what we make them. Thus, dependence on a Power Supreme is taught, and that manhood is required to accomplish the great purpose of our being. In native element only, can man that wisdom know, that character attain, and that purpose fulfil. Does man possess such happy estate ? Let the 5,900 years history of tears, wails and deaths ; heart restlessness and agony ; mental darkness, superstition and disquiet ; spiritual capacities, whose void the world could never fill, answer ! True, the wreck of Mansoul is "magnificent even in ruins ;" but this makes the scene more sad, and shows that the moral nature is imperishable.'

The cause of all this woe, where blessings might abound, is told by the Apostle : "The world by wisdom knew not God." The curtains of Spiritual Night are drawn over the Sea of Moral Death, and the shrinking soul must his doom abide forever, unless saved. Upon this sea, the Gospel Life Boat is launched, and amid the roaring tempests and dashing billows of Time's Centuries, the voice of the Pilot is heard above the "noise of waters :" "Deliver him from going down to the pit, I have found a ransom." should not perish, but have everlasting life." All who believe this Gospel, are, by their Lord, commissioned from his Father's Throne, to make his grace to mortals known. The call original, is : " Go ye, therefore, and teach all nations." Go teach the teachings of God's Son, empowered as with the Holy Ghost come upon you, and ye shall be witnesses unto me, unto the uttermost parts of the earth.

" Then shall the heathen, filled with awe,
Learn the blest knowledge of God's law,
And Anti-Christ, on every shore,
Fall from his throne to rise no more."

This Divine commission requires the vigorous, constant efforts of the Church Jesus bought with His own blood. The hallowed worship of their united souls must be laid on the altar that sanctifieth the gift. Opportunities watched and prayed for, as Paul when in vision, he beheld a man across the stream and heard the cry—"Come over and help us." Who can measure the results of Paul's response, as with heart and life, he preached the Gospel to our forefathers in Europe and Britain. Wesley heard that call in his day, and O'Brien, and Eynon, and Metherell, and Chapple, and others of like mind, and those who sent them. From heathen lands and new countries, the cry is heard, and the Church will soon, we trust, appreciate the call and dispense freely and gladly the treasures of salvation to earth's remotest bounds. Eternity will but increase the volume of Heavenly praises, sung by the redeemed through such instrumentalities. Will Bible Christians arise, and in worship of sacrifice, relieve the Missionary Treasury of its present indebtedness? then, in enlarged spheres of usefulness in Ontario, and N. W. Provinces and Territories, and with richer baptisms of the Holy Spirit, we may aid in spreading Scriptural holiness throughout those lands.

Our Mission Fields are reported as follows :--

PORT HOPE—W. H. Butt, Pastor.—Our success has not been all that could have been desired, still, on the whole, we have made progress. Prayer Meetings are well attended and very profitable, but Class Meetings are sadly neglected by many. The Sabbath School is well officered and ably conducted, and the Pastor's Bible Class, (numbering 42 persons), is a very interesting department of Church work. Temperance Meetings, held quarterly, under the auspices of the Sabbath School, are largely attended, and afford splendid opportunities for the exercise and development of latent talents that lie slumbering in the breasts of some of our promising young men and gifted young ladies. Encouraged by the promises of God, and successes of the past,

we resolve to grasp the standard more firmly and, bearing it aloft, march onward till it shall be planted and unfurled in holy triumph on the hill-top of victory.

HUNGERFORD—T. J. Sabine, Pastor.—Some are striving together for the faith, and with earnest heart and liberal hand, to sustain the cause of God. A larger number seem indifferent to the interest of the Denomination and the glory of God. Congregations about the same as last year, but the success for which we hoped, has not as yet been seen.

CAMPBELLFORD—J. G. Yelland, J. Pooley, Pastors.—We have preached, prayed, entreated, warned, and visited, with little visible effect. The station suffers the lack of leading members, in several of the appointments. No Sabbath Schools, or other social and public means of grace, except when held by one of the ministers. We want more Aarons and Hurs, more brotherly love and regard for a brother's feelings. Though cast down we are not destroyed. Special Services, held during three months, were attended with little visible results. In the midst of our labors, many have been the refreshing manifestations of God's presence, cheering us in our work of faith and labor of love. Congregations and Sabbath Schools about the same as last year; except at Campbellford, here the congregation has considerably improved. Many of our friends give liberally, while others do little or nothing. In the face of our common foe, leaning on the Divine arm, our motto is "Fight and Conquer."

BELL VILLE—A. Schuster, Pastor.—The word proclaimed has shown its scattering, as well as its ingathering effects, and a few have held firm to our cause. God has greatly blessed both Pastor and people. Sabbath School is increasing. Congregations have steadily increased and promise well for the future. We believe Belleville Mission has seen its darkest days. Our financial position, under the circumstances, is as good as last year. We have peace in our midst, and prosperity is sure to follow. This Mission, if carefully treated, will, in a few years, rank among the best in the Denomination.

PRINCE ALBERT—R. Allin, Pastor.—During another year, precious seed has been sown with but little apparent fruit. We toil on, hoping, and praying, that the seed sown may bear fruit after many days. Our services are moderately well attended, and at times have been characterized by the presence and power of the Spirit. Class and Prayer Meetings are not so well attended as their importance demands. When our members are as prompt and faithful in attending all the means of grace as they are in their temporal affairs, then may we expect prosperity in every department of our work. Financially, our receipts equal disbursements.

PERRYTOWN—G. Bodle, Pastor.—Another year closes and not much spiritual or material improvement visible. The effort at beginning of the year to secure a Parsonage, resulted in grievous disappointment. Special Services were held at Providence, and not without some good to the Church. Congregations good at Providence and Eden; at Perrytown not so large. Finances are not in so healthy a condition as desirable. Regular quarterly payments would greatly improve this feature of our work.

PETERBORO'—E. Roberts, Pastor.—That must have been a holy, devoted and consistent Church, and he a happy, joyful Pastor, to warrant Paul's assertion to the Church at Phillipi. "I thank my God upon every remembrance of you." We see much to indicate God's presence, graciousness and power; much that tells of his faithfulness to his promises and delight in his people; much that gladdens our hearts while we recall it to remembrance. Yet with increased faithfulness more would have been done. Greater diligence would have made us wiser and holier, and usefulness would have accorded with our advantages. A few souls were gathered into the fold of Jesus, in town, and also at Bethel, who bid fair to dwell in God's House and be pillars therein. Congregations are about the same as last year. Attendance of some is irregular, allowing slight indisposition, a little inclement weather, or a practice of Sabbath visitation, to keep them from the House of God. We find great difficulty in securing a suitable supply of teachers for the Sabbath School. This indicates a want of full consecration to God's work. Debt on Peterboro' property reduced by \$275.00, besides meeting current expenditures. The Trust Estate is now in a safe, workable condition. We have sustained the loss of several valuable members, through removals, but report a few more members than last year.

FENELON—J. M. Tredrea, Pastor.—We have scattered the seeds of Divine Truth; some has fallen into stoney ground and among thorns, but some into good ground, bringing forth fruit. Twenty-two have been received into the fellowship of the Church; several on trial have been discontinued; several have removed. Attendance at Class and Prayer Meetings, taking the Bible as our standard, is not what it should be. Many of our friends give evidence of the power of the Gospel of Christ to save. Depression in trade, and failure of crops affect our finances.

LINDSAY—R. T. Courtice, Pastor—Reports a year of peace and harmony in each department of our work. Growing interest in the Sabbath School. Prayer and Class Meetings are seasons of blessing, though, by many, not attended regularly as desirable. The Church debt is not diminished.

MANVERS AND CARTWRIGHT—J. Whitlock, M. Metherell, Pastors.—“The Lord of Hosts is with us and the God of Jacob is our refuge.” Congregations are good and Societies prospering. Members are living in peace and working harmoniously to build up, consolidate and extend the cause of God. Special Meetings held at Janetville, Fleetwood and Cæsarea, were seasons of grace and Divine Power. Over one hundred persons manifested a desire to be saved, ninety of whom united with us in Church fellowship, and up to this time, are growing in grace. We hope for improvement in the Sabbath School department of our work. We report with gratitude to God an increase in the year, of thirty-four approved members, and thirty-one on trial. We thank God and take courage, praying daily that God will build up Zion, lengthen her cords, strengthen her stakes, and that converts by hundreds may crowd her gates.

ASHBURNHAM—J. W. Cannom, Pastor.—By removals and unfaithfulness, our membership is less than last year. Quarterly Receipts have improved, and if all would do their duty, instead of allowing the burden to rest on a few, there would be no difficulty in meeting all demands of the Quarter Board. Interest and \$60.00 of the principal of Church debt have been met. What we want most is an outpouring of the Spirit. May the Lord revive His work.

TORONTO—W. Joliffe, Pastor.—It becomes us to express our gratitude to God for His preserving care graciously vouchsafed us. The continued fluctuations and scattered condition of our Society and Congregations, are felt to be a disadvantage, preventing many from regular attendance at Church services. Finances have been seriously affected by the monetary depression of the times; nevertheless, the friends have succeeded, in a fair degree, in meeting our financial obligations. Although much has been done during the past few years towards reducing the debt on Church and Parsonage, (sufficient to deserve commendation), yet the remaining obligations are such as to necessitate the treatment of this Mission with the utmost possible favour. Seasons of refreshing, coming from the presence of the Lord, both in public and social means of grace, have been enjoyed, although few conversions. Many are holding on their way; others, again, are tardy in the way of life. Our Sabbath School sustains the usual interest. Missionary Contributions have increased. We will hope for the fulfilment of the Divine promise in the final conquest and triumph of truth, believing that faithful is He that hath promised or called who also will do it.

PICKERING—A. Gordon, Pastor.—Peace generally prevails. Public and social services have been means of spiritual profit. Two of our number have put off the sandals of their pilgrimage, and have left the toils and perils of this wilderness, for the rest and safety of our Father's home above. Many of our people residing at inconvenient distances from places of worship, renders their attendance at weekly Prayer Meetings and Sunday Services irregular. This, and unfavorable weather, have prevented our holding Special Services with any prospect of success. The severe affliction of Bro. Bunting and Sister Gordon, has made it impossible to keep up our regular appointments. We are resolved to pray, and work, and trust, until our loving God shall crown us with His richer blessings of abundant success.

HAMILTON—J. J. Rice, Pastor.—The year has been one of peace and harmony among us as a Church. Our affairs were in a very discouraging condition financially and spiritually, at the beginning of the year. By the Divine blessing things have considerably improved. Congregations and Sunday School increased. Sabbath Collections, Quarterages and Missionary Money, advanced, and expenses and debt reduced. The membership also is enlarged. On the whole, the year's operations have been such, as to give encouragement concerning the future of our cause in this city.

UXBBIDGE—J. Holmes, Pastor.—The Pastor's health failing so soon after Conference, disappointments occurred, and their usual results followed. Yet we have reason to be grateful. God's presence has made our Divine joys very great. General harmony and good will prevail, and many of our members give evidences of true and growing piety and increasing interest in the Master's cause. Class and Prayer Meetings are means of great spiritual good, and well attended. Sabbath Schools (especially Uxbridge) are doing earnest work. Financially, owing to illness, we are considerably in arrears.

SUTTON—D. Williams, Pastor.—Amid varied experiences, we have struggled on, leaning on the arm Omnipotent.. Financially, heavy indebtedness has a discouraging influence on our Societies, especially Sutton ; however, we have succeeded in paying off some small debts and meeting all claims for interest. Missionary receipts are also largely increased. Spiritually, we cannot report that holy zeal in Christian work, that entire renunciation of the spirit of the world, and urgent struggling after the higher life that should obtain. Yet our Societies live in peace and we have the presence of the Master among us, adding seals to our ministry, for which we say, God be praised. Special Meetings, held at Egypt and Sutton, were seasons of reviving

influence. A goodly number gave heed to the word and turned to God. We suffer from the entire absence of local help. May the Lord send us a gracious and general quickening.

PALMERSTON—J. Veale, Pastor.—Signs following the preaching of the Word have not been as glorious as desirable. We have been living in peace, with little improvement in our spiritual experiences. Palmerston Congregation has increased, and since morning service has been held, the Class Meetings are better attended. Sabbath School is now held in the afternoon—an improvement. Minto Society has the cause of God at heart, but there is not much room for extension. Fordwich has suffered through removals and other causes.

WIARTON—G. Dunkley, Pastor.—We have not realized the enlarged outpouring of the Holy Spirit, fondly hoped for; nevertheless, a few souls have found the pearl of great price, and many of our services have been seasons of refreshing, coming from the presence of the Lord. Congregations, on the whole, are good. Sabbath Schools working well. Membership has increased. On account of financial difficulties, and the ground being also occupied by other sections of the Church, this station will require financial aid for many years to come.

CLINTON—R. Thomas, Pastor.—Special Services in town were well attended, and the Divine presence graciously realized. Believers were quickened, and several were converted and added to the Church. At Holmesville, the Society is peaceful and constant in religious devotion; rather consolidating than expanding. A larger church is needed to hold our evening Congregation, which we anticipate building soon as convenient. As the result of removals, Summerhill Society and Congregations are small, and the material interests of the Church seriously affected. London Road Congregation is small, but the few attending are attentive and grateful hearers. Mount Hope needs a Church in order to the building up of a Society in that place. Sabbath Schools, where held, are in a very flourishing condition, and several scholars have joined the Church. May they, with us, have within the walls of God's House, a place and a name better than that of sons and daughters, an everlasting name that shall not be cut off.

LONDON EAST—G. H. Copeland, Pastor.—The past year has been one of earnest endeavor, happy co-operation, and encouraging prosperity. Many times we have exclaimed, "The Lord of Hosts is with us, and the God of Jacob is our refuge." Finances have been well sustained. Congregations are increased, and Class and Prayer Meetings greatly improved. Peace and harmony have obtained during the year. Our "Ladies' Aid,"

organized during the year, has done substantial service.. The Sabbath School, with efficient working, is increasingly prosperous. The outlook is such as to evoke gratitude and inspire courage.

LONDON SOUTH—W. Rollins, Pastor.—In reviewing the ecclesiastical year, its labors and rewards, its trials and triumphs, we have abundant reasons for gratefulness to our Heavenly Father for all his manifestation of love toward us. Financially, we have done admirably, raising by the "Envelope System" sufficient to meet all our liabilities; numerically we were never as strong as at the present. Congregations, morning and evening, are good; Church comfortably filled; which fact, taken in connection with our rapidly filling village, has led to taking measures towards the erection of a new Church edifice. We held a series of meetings for five weeks. God greatly blessed us. Forty persons were received on trial, the majority of whom have passed into full membership. In the Sabbath School department, we also report progress. We believe our members are living near the Lord. Peace and harmony reign within our borders. We re-dedicate ourselves to God's service, while our prayer is

"O, Jesus, ride on till all are subdued,
Thy mercy make known and sprinkle thy blood;
Display thy salvation, and teach the new song,
To every nation, and people, and tongue."

INGERSOLL—J. Archer, Pastor.—We feel grateful to say our labors have not been altogether in vain. Congregation in town has increased. We have suffered seriously through removals of eighteen members, besides some outside the Church, who supported us. The Spirit of the Lord has wrought with us, so that we report an increase in membership. Our Sabbath School has sustained great loss through removals of some of its best workers, but is prospering as well as could be expected under the circumstances, and our Societies are earnestly praying "O Lord revive Thy work." Financially, the friends, with "Ladies' Aid" Auxiliary, have done nobly. Debt on Parsonage reduced by \$30. We are praying for more abundant prosperity.

LAMBETH—T. Mason, Pastor.—Though we are not, in spirit or practice, all we ought to be, yet we are thankful to God for the measure of his grace enjoyed by the members generally. Public services have been heartily sustained and earnest desire manifested for a fuller consecration of the Lord's work. God has graciously made his power felt among us during nine weeks of Special Union Services, by which seventy persons were led to see themselves as sinners, and to cry to God for mercy. About one-third of these united with us. Financially, there is good

reason to think, that when all do their duty, this station can easily take an independent position.

ST. THOMAS—W. Hooper, Pastor.—Of our spiritual state we may say, that the type of piety with us, as a rule, is not so high as could be desired. We are not, however, without evidences of the Divine Presence in our assemblies. Some of our members are irregular in attendance at Prayer and Class Meetings; others appear to content themselves by attending one public service on the Sabbath. We held Special Services in the winter, followed by Cottage Prayer Meetings. A few appeared to be under serious impressions; and united on trial, but we have little abiding fruit. Our Sabbath morning Congregations are small; the evening is twice as large, as a rule. We have at present peace, and hope for prosperity. Sabbath School increases in numbers and influence, and is the most hopeful feature of things in this Mission Church. Several of our members are very liberal, but numbers are small and our debt heavy, which has a discouraging effect upon our best friends. In the midst of all we thank God and take courage.

TALBOTVILLE—R. Mallet, B. A., Pastor.—God be thanked for peace within our borders this year, and a small measure of spiritual prosperity. At Talbotville a good Parsonage has been erected, and quite a sum raised towards paying for it. A neat and commodious Church has been dedicated and almost paid for at Front Street. Several of the senior scholars in the Sabbath School have sought the pearl of greatest price, and many newly united with the Church, are already useful, distributing tracts and aiding to support the Mission. From all sources, about eleven hundred dollars have been raised this year. Church and Parsonage debt has been reduced by nearly four hundred dollars, and two hundred dollars of interest paid. Sunday School and Band of Hope are prospering. Our Juvenile Missionary effort was successful. We hope in the God of Israel. May He crown our efforts here with abundant success.

Various parts of the Province have been visited, means of grace provided, and Societies formed. We trust the little one shall become a thousand. The erection of a Church is contemplated at Alexandria, and also at Snowflake. Our services, public and social, have been characterized by much of the Divine presence and power.
