THEY RECEIVE THEIR FRIENDS AND PARTAKE THEIR LAST MEAL. PARTICIPATION OF THE LAST EVENING OF THE PRISONERS AND OF THE EXECUTION.

BY TELEGRAPH TO THE GAZETTE. NEW YORK, August 28.—The four murderers received the farewell visits of their friends and relatives, early last evening, and then took a turn around the yard for their last experience of air and recreation.

They smoked, laughed, and chatted as if they had no connection with the ordeal of the coming day. Carolin who was the most restive of the party, partially asked to see the gallows. He examined the structure carefully, shook the uprights with his hands and seemed satisfied with their stability.

"That's all right," he said "but it isn't an artistic job, it should be painted black." The warden looked at him and said "You are a curious fellow, then after night prayers by the priest they were taken to their cells.
