#### MEETINGS.

The Regular Meetings of the Society are held quarterly, on the 25th March, or Lady Day; 24th June, or Midsummer Day; 29th September, or Michaelmas Day; and the 26th December.

Annual Election of Officers and Committees takes place on 5th January.

The Members meet also on 23rd April-St. George's Day.

The Meetings of the Committee of Management are held on the second Monday in every month.

/ The Meetings of the Sub-Committee of Charity are held weekly.

#### RELIEF.

Application for Relief should be made on a Printed Form, stating the particulars of the case, &c., signed by any two members of the Society as a recommendation, and handed to the Sub-Committee of Charity.

Members may also bring up any case of distress within their knowledge at any of the above meetings.

The Printed Forms above mentioned may be had on application to any of the officers.

There are six beds, with the necessary bedding, all the property of the Society, in the Finlay Asylum, for the use of persons who may be sent to that Institution by the Society.

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#### SIXTIETH ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

# Committee of Management of St. George's Society of Quebec,

#### FOR THE YEAR 1895.

The Committee of Management have the honour to submit the following report of their proceedings during the past year, being the sixtieth since the foundation of the Society.

The anniversary of St. George's Day was celebrated by Divine Service in the Cathedral, at which the Rev. Lennox W. Williams, M.A., one of the Chaplains of the Society, kindly preached an eloquent sermon.

The musical part of the Service was admirably rendered by the talented choir and other ladies and gentlemen under the able direction of Mr. E. A. Bisnop, organist, to all of whom the Society is again indebted for their valuable assistance.

The collection amounted to the handsome sum of \$55.00.

The report of the Sub-Committee of Charity shows the Society has relieved 173 cases of distress during the year, at an outlay of \$427.85. (See report of Sub-Committee of Charity.) All these cases were attended to by the Chairman, Mr. Heber Budden, who dispensed assistance with his usual good judgment and satisfactory results. The thanks of the Society are due to him for his constant devotion and exercise of patience under the circumstances.

The financial affairs of the Society are very satisfactory, for which we are indebted to our worthy treasurer, Mr. F. Billingsley.

We regret to say that death has again been amongst us and removed many worthy members in the persons of Mr. W. H. Jeffery, a life member since 1845; Mr. Cornelius Judge, a life member since 1870, a member of the Com-

mittee of Management and a past President; by his death, the Society loses one who always took a lively interest in the working of the Society and he will be greatly missed at the meetings; and Messrs. E. Ashe, Commander R. Logie H. Dunn, George Payne and John Y. Welch, ordinary members.

Four new members have been elected, two life and two ordinary. The resident membership now stands at 119, of

During many years and up to the time of his death, Bishop Mountain, besides his line membership, contributed regularly to the Society a donation equal to four annual subscriptions, and at all times took a great interest in its proceedings. 


