## BILL.

### An Act further to amend the Lower Canada Consolidated Municipal Act.

**W**HEREAS it is desirable to amend the Act recited in the title of this Act ; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. The restrictions contained in the eleventh sub-section of the fiftieth section of the Lower Canada Consolidated Municipal Act shall not apply to Incorporated Villages, so as to deprive the local Councils thereof of authority to mark out and open any new street, alley or lane, or turn or widen, alter, change or direct, any old one within the Municipality, in such manner as the same shall pass through any enclosed or unenclosed garden, farm-yard or orchard, or to demolish or injure any house, barn or other building whatsoever, with or without the consent of the proprietor of the same ; and every such Council shall have such authority as aforesaid.
