MONTREAL HUNT.

Constitution and Rules.

1. This club shall be called the Name
"MONTREAL HUNT."

2. There shall be a Committee Committee
of
Managemen't
for the general management of the
affairs of the Hunt, consisting of the
Master, Hon. Secretary, and five
other members, of which three shall
form a quorum.

3. The master of the Hounds shall Master.
be the Chairman at all meetings,
and besides taking charge of every-
thing in the field, he shall see to
the interior economy of the Hunt,
and that all contracts and agree-
ments are carried out.

Hon. Sec'y. 4. The Hon. Secretary, shall keep the books, collect subscriptions, etc., under the directions of the Master.

Committee 5. The Committee will assist the other officers of the Hunt with their advice and co-operation.

6. Any member of the Committee can act for the Master or Hon. Secretary if they be unable to attend to their duties.

7. Sales, contracts, etc., must be laid before the Committee.

New Members 8. The names of candidates for membership must be forwarded to the Hon. Secretary in writing, and the application signed by both the proposer and the seconder. The ballot for the election of such candidate shall not take place until the name shall have been posted in

the Club-house for ten days previous to the date of the ballot.

9. One black ball in five to ex-Ballot clude.

10. On the admission of each new member, the Hon. Secretary shall notify the same to him, and furnish him with a printed copy of the Constitution and Rules, and request him to remit the amount of his subscription.

11. Any member who by his conduct has given cause for complaint, may be expelled from the membership by a four-fifths vote of the meeting at which the question is brought up. Expulsion of Members.

12. Any member wishing to resign must forward his resignation in writing to the Hon. Secretary on or before the Annual General Meeting. Resignation of Members.

Any member failing to comply with this rule will be liable for his subscription for the following year.

Election of
Officers.

13. The election of the officers of the Hunt shall take place at the Annual Meeting, and they shall hold office until the date of the next Annual Meeting. The gentlemen who have a majority of votes will be elected.

Annual
Meeting.

14. There shall be an Annual General Meeting in January of each year, to elect the officers, receive the accounts, and attend to any other business in connection with the Hunt's affairs.

Extra-
ordinary
Meetings.

15. If required, a General Meeting of the Members of the Hunt may be called by the Master at any time, upon giving the requisite notice.

16. Any five members have the right to demand a General Meeting ; said demand to be forwarded to the Master in writing, stating with what object the demand is made. The Master will then call a General Meeting, the day of said meeting to be within ten days of receipt of requisition.

17. All meetings must be called either by advertisement in the newspapers or by a separate notification to each member at least three days before the date of the meeting.

18. Seven members to form a quo-^{Quorum}rum at any General Meeting called as above.

19. The Master or Chairman shall have a vote in every division in addition to a casting vote.

20. The Annual Subscription shall ^{Subscription.}

be Fifty Dollars, payable in advance on the first of March. All subscriptions unpaid on the first of April shall be posted at the Club-house.

21 Any member six months in arrears of his subscription will cease to be a member on the first of September unless he can give sufficient and good reason for such delay.

Race
Meetings

22. Any race meeting under Hunt auspices cannot take place unless decided upon at a General Meeting called for the purpose, and the expenses of said race meeting must be kept separate from the Hunt accounts.

23. All Stewards elected for such races shall be chosen from the members exclusively, with the exception of the Mayor of the City of Montreal for the time being.

24. The Master, the Hon. Secretary and Committee shall be *ipso facto* Stewards, and the Master President of them.

25. Any article of this constitution may be altered, amended or suspended for any range of time by consent of two-thirds of the members present at any meeting specially convened for that purpose, provided that such alteration, amendment or suspension shall have been specified in the notice summoning such meeting or at any Annual General Meeting of the Hunt.

26. All Hunt races shall be run under "The Montreal Hunt rules of Racing," except when special rules are published on the programme. The programme to be prepared and

announced previous to the 1st of August in each year.

Honorary
Members.

27. All masters of Fox Hounds of any recognized Hunt in Canada and the United States may be made honorary members of the Montreal Hunt during their term of office, and enjoy all privileges of ordinary members, with the exception of the right of voting.

Uniform

28. The uniform of the Hunt to be Scarlet Coats and dark blue facings.
