BILL.

An Act to continue for a limited time the several Acts and Ordinances therein mentioned.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to continue the Preamble.
Acts and Ordinances hereinafter mentioned, which would otherwise expire at the end of the present Session :
Be it therefore, &c.

- 5 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,
That the Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed
in the Session held in the third and fourth years of Her
Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to regulate the* 4 and 5 Vict.
"*Fisheries in the District of Gaspé;*"—the Act of the said c. 36.
- 10 Parliament, passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's
Reign, and intituled, "*An Act for the better preservation* 8 Vict. c. 6.
"*of the Peace, and the prevention of riots and violent out-*
"*rages at and near Public Works while in progress of con-*
"*struction ;*"—the Act of the said Parliament, passed in
15 the same year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An* 8 Vict. c. 27.
"*Act to amend the Act and Ordinance therein mentioned,*
"*relative to the Registration of Titles to, and incumbrances*
"*upon, Real Property in Lower Canada ;*—the Act of the
said Parliament, passed in the same year of Her Majesty's
Reign, and intituled, "*An Act for the relief of Insolvent* 8 Vict. c. 48.
- 20 "*Debtors in Upper Canada, and for other purposes therein*
"*mentioned ;*"—the Act of the said Parliament, passed in
the same year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An* 8 Vict. c. 53.
"*Act to repeal certain Acts therein mentioned, and better*
"*to encourage Agriculture in Lower Canada, by the estab-*
25 "*lishment of Agricultural Societies therein,*" excepting so
much of the said last mentioned Act as is repealed by the
Act of the said Parliament, passed in the ninth year of Her
Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to amend the Act* 9 Vict. c. 14.
"*for the encouragement of Agriculture by the establishment*
30 "*of Agricultural Societies in Lower Canada,*" and the said
last mentioned Act ;—the Act of the said Parliament, pass-
ed in the said ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and
intituled, "*An Act to allow the formation of more than one* 9 Vict. c. 24.
"*Agricultural Society in a County in Lower Canada, and*
35 "*for the relief of the Society for the County of Montreal ;*"
—the Act of the said Parliament passed in the same year of
Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "*An Act to empower* 9 Vict. c. 38.
"*Commissioners for inquiring into matters connected with*
"*the public business, to take evidence on oath ;*"—the Act
40 of the said Parliament, passed in the Session held in the
tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and inti-
tuled, "*An Act to enlarge the powers of the Trinity House of* 10 & 11 V. c. 1.

- Montreal in certain cases where the Public Health of the City*
 “may be endangered;”—the Act of the said Parliament,
 11 Vict. c. 7. intituled, “*An Act to provide for the Inspection of Butter in Que-*
 “*bec and Montreal;*”—the Act of the said Parliament, pass- 5

 “*St. Antoine, commonly called the Baie du Febvre, to ter-*
 “*minate certain disputes relating to the limits of the said*
 “*Common, and for other purposes appertaining to the*
 “*same;*”—the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the 25
 9 Geo. 4, c. 20. ninth year of the same Reign, and intituled, “*An Act to*
 “*provide for the more effectual extinction of secret incum-*
 “*brances on lands than was heretofore in use in this Pro-*
 “*vince;*”—the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the
 9 Geo. 4, c. 27. same year of the same reign, and intituled, “*An Act to* 30
 “*prevent fraudulent Debtors evading their Creditors in*
 “*certain parts of this Province;*”—the Act of the said
 Parliament, passed in the same year of the same Reign,
 9 Geo. 4, c. 28. and intituled, “*An Act to facilitate the proceedings against*
 “*the Estates and Effects of Debtors in certain cases;*”— 35
 the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the same year of
 9 Geo. 4, c. 32. the same reign, and intituled, “*An Act to alter and amend*
 “*an Act, passed in the sixth year of His Majesty’s Reign,*
 “*intituled, ‘An Act to authorize the inhabitants of the*
 “*‘Fief Grosbois, in the County of Saint Maurice; to* 40
 “*‘make Regulations for the Common of the said Fief;’*”—
 the Act of the said Parliament passed in the same year
 9 Geo. 4 c. 51. of the same Reign, and intituled, “*An Act for the preser-*
 “*vation of the Salmon Fisheries in the Counties of Corn-*
 “*wallis and Northumberland;*”—the Act of the said Parlia- 45
 ment, passed in the first year of the Reign of His late
 1 Will. 4 c. 6. Majesty King William the Fourth, and intituled, “*An*
 “*Act to encourage the destruction of wolves;*”—the Act of
 the said Parliament, passed in the third year of the same
 3 Wm. 4 c. 14. Reign, and intituled, “*An Act further to suspend certain* 50
 “*parts of an Act or Ordinance therein mentioned, and to*
 “*consolidate and further to continue for a limited time the*
 “*provisions of two other Acts therein mentioned, for more*
 “*effectually ascertaining the damages on protested Bills of*

“exchange, and for determining disputes relating thereto,
 “and for other purposes;”—the Act of the said Parliament,
 passed in the sixth year of the same Reign, and intituled,
 “*An Act to regulate the fees of persons employed by Justices* 6 Wm. 4 c. 19.
 5 *of the Peace, in the Country Parishes, as Clerks or Bailiffs*
in certain cases;”—the Act of the said Parliament, passed
in the same year of the same Reign, and intituled, “An 6 Wm. 4 c. 35,
 “*Act to provide for the medical treatment of sick mariners;”—*
 —the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the same
 10 year of the same Reign, and intituled, “*An Act to repeal* 6 Wm. 4 c. 56.
 “*a certain Act therein mentioned, and more effectually to*
 “*remedy divers abuses prejudicial to agriculture;”—the*
 Ordinance of the Special Council of the said Province,
 passed in the third Session of the said Council, held in
 15 the second year of Her Majesty’s Reign, and intituled,
 “*An Ordinance to amend the Act passed in the thirty-* 2 Vict (3) c. 7.
 “*sixth year of the Reign of King George the Third,*
 “*chapter nine, commonly called the Road Act;”—the Act*
 of the Parliament of the late Province of Upper Canada,
 20 passed in the eleventh year of the Reign of His late Ma-
 jesty, King George the Fourth, and intituled, “*An Act to* U. C.
 “*authorize the Quarter Sessions of the Home District to* 11 Geo. 4 c. 20.
 “*provide for the relief of Insane Destitute persons in that*
 “*District;”—the Act of the said Parliament, passed in*
 25 the third year of the Reign of His late Majesty, King
 William the Fourth, and intituled, “*An Act to continue* 3 Wm. 4 c. 45.
 “*an Act passed in the eleventh year of His late Majesty’s*
 “*Reign, intituled, ‘An Act to authorize the Quarter*
 “*Sessions of the Home District to provide for the relief of*
 30 “*Insane Destitute persons in that District, and to extend*
 “*the provisions of the same to the other Districts of this*
 “*Province;’—and the Act of the said Parliament,*
 passed in the sixth year of the same Reign, and intituled,
 “*An Act passed in the forty-ninth year of the Reign of His* 6 Wm. 4. c. 29,
 35 “*late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, ‘An Act* continued.
 “*to encourage the destroying of wolves in this Province,*
 “*and to make further provision for the extermination of*
 “*those destructive animals;”—shall be, and all and every*
 of the said Acts and Ordinances are hereby continued to the
 40 First day of January next, and from thence until the end
 of the then next ensuing Session of the Parliament, and
 no longer.

II. And be it enacted, That the Act of the Parliament of
 this Province, passed in the seventh year of Her Majesty’s
 45 Reign, and intituled, “*An Act to repeal an Ordinance of* 7 Vict. c. 10.
 “*Lower Canada, intituled, an Ordinance concerning*
 “*Bankrupts, and the administration and distribution of their*
 “*estates and effects, and to make provision for the same*
 “*object throughout the Province of Canada;” and the Act*
 50 amending the same, passed in the ninth year of Her Ma-
 jesty’s Reign, and intituled, “*An Act to continue and* 9 Vict. c. 30.
 “*amend the Bankrupt Laws now in force in this Province”*
 in so far only as the same are continued by and for the

And 12 Vict. c. 18 continued to a certain extent. purposes mentioned in the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to make provision for the continuance and completion of proceedings in Bankruptcy now pending.*" and the said last mentioned Act, shall respectively be and they are hereby continued and shall remain in force until the said first day of January next, and thence until the end of the then next ensuing Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer. 5

Proviso: this Act not to affect any Act passed this Session repealing &c., any of the above Acts. III. Provided always, and be it enacted, That nothing herein contained, shall prevent or be construed to prevent the effect of any Act passed or to be passed during the present Session, repealing, amending, rendering permanent, or continuing to any further period than that herein appointed, any of the Acts or Ordinances hereinbefore mentioned and continued. 10 15
