An Act to amend the law of Dower in Upper Canada.

5 **WHEREAS** it is desirable to repeal the sixteenth section of the Act ^{Preamble} twenty-fourth Victoria, chapter forty, intituled, "An Act for the better assignment of Dower in Upper Canada, and to extend the provisions of the said Act : Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

10 **1.** The sixteenth section of the said Act is hereby repealed, except ^{Sect. 16 re-} ing only as to all cases in which dower has actually been assigned and possession taken either under an act of assignment of Dower or under ^{pealed.} agreement between the parties; at the time of passing this Act.

2. The provisions of the said Act shall apply to all cases other than ^{To what cases} those excepted in the foregoing section. ^{the said Act} shall apply.

3. This Act shall apply to Upper Canada only. ^{Act limited to} U. C.
