He threw the plank from the rails and a bullet from a revolver whizzed past his head. He had not reached the door when the express thundered up the track.

Sixty-Five Dollars in Cash and a Gold Watch the Best. Chelsey, Sept. 14.—Last night or early this morning a thief entered the residence of Mr. W. H. Chelsey, and while the family were asleep and stole \$65 in cash and a gold watch and chain valued at \$10.

CANADA'S HIGHEST PEAK.

Mount St. Elias, which is not in the United States. Ottawa, Sept. 14.—It has been discovered in a recent survey of the mountains between Canada and Alaska that Mount St. Elias, so long regarded as the giant mountain of the Canadian side of the Canadian, not United States territory.

What was almost an interesting was the determination of the height of the mountain. This was found to be 18,028 feet, considerably higher than the estimate given by the numerous exploring parties of the geological survey of the city.

Which Probably Explains Why the Miranda Was Wrecked. Chicago, Sept. 14.—A special from Ottawa, Ontario, Sept. 14, says that the Cook Greenleaf excursion party, has returned to Toronto with the estimate that on the morning the Miranda sank nearly the entire crew of sailors were so intoxicated that they had to be helped from the vessel when she went down. The reef on which the vessel struck, has been plainly marked on the chart.

Experiments in Bacteriology.

The well known French bacteriologist M. d'Arsonval, has been lately endeavoring to prepare a germicidal water for medicinal purposes, by submitting them to the action of carbonic gas at a pressure of fifty to sixty atmospheres. This treatment, M. d'Arsonval believes will kill the microbes which are present in the liquids and renders them, therefore, sterile or germ free.

Experiments in Bacteriology.

French investigators have more recently taken the subject, and they say that carbonic acid gas is more powerful than typhoid fever and other similar bacteria. These investigations remind us of the success of the microbes in artificially created water, from which it appears that the bacterial contents such water are not dependent upon the carbonic acid gas present, but rather upon the initial purity of the water employed.

School Committees Meet.

The Supply Committee of the Public School Board met yesterday afternoon, Messrs. Hamby, Burns, Baird and Charlton were present. The committee will meet again on the 19th inst. at 8:00 A.M. and also ordered extra seats for Dulwich school, at 4.20 per seat.

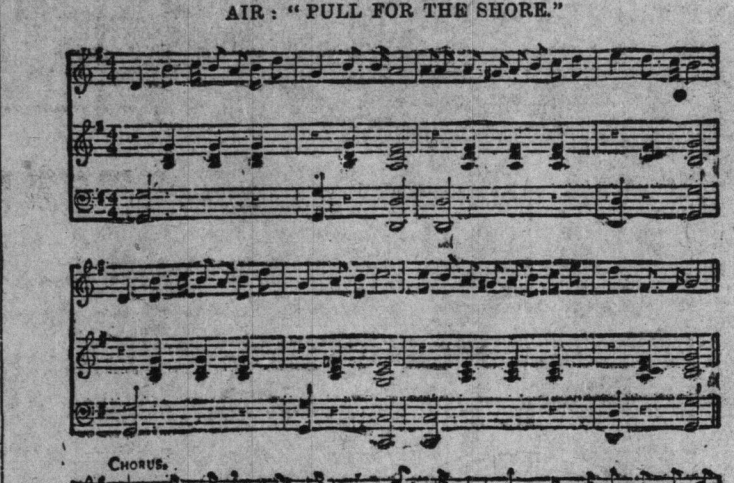
