AT THE SESSIONS. Convicted of Assaulting a Bailiff—Charged With Stealing Sheep.

On Jan. 20 last a charge of hooliganism was stolen from the premises of Plunkett & Meagher, corner of Broadview and Danforth-avenue. On the night of Feb. 18 they were found in the middle of Danforth-avenue, about 300 yards east of Plunkett & Meagher's premises.

Two young men, Harrison and Eroy, who lived in Munro-street, were charged with the theft. They were connected with the transaction by the evidence of Charles Ferguson, who recently lived next door to Harrison. He noticed an item in the East End Advocate of the loss of the sheep and traced the youths with perishing them. According to his evidence they admitted it and promised to replace them. The witness Ferguson is the young man who was tried at these sessions on the charge of stealing bottles of chemicals from the Technical School and acquitted. Harrison and Eroy were placed on trial at the Sessions yesterday. The case will be concluded this morning.

William Milligan was tried yesterday at the County Sessions, charged with assaulting and ejecting one McGraw, a man in possession, at his home, 101 Cumberland-street, for \$10, a month's rent. The defence was that McGraw was a trespasser, who had been left in charge by Allingham, a bailiff, and Allingham's authority was challenged. The assault was not very serious, but the jury ultimately convicted him. Judge McDougall sentenced him to pay a fine of \$10 within a week, or 30 days imprisonment, intimating that if the month's rent was paid he would reduce the fine to a nominal amount. Mr. J. A. Ferguson defended.

New York, May 22.—Herbert Cottrell of Newark, New Jersey, has received a United States patent, and also a Canadian patent, on a telephone without electrodes, which operates on the principle of an electrical shunt, having a path of high resistance and a path of low resistance, whereby the necessary variations in the current may be produced.
