REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE
FOR THE YEAR 1882-83.

At the close of another year the Committee, in submitting the Forty-fifth Annual Report of this Society, desire again to acknowledge the "good hand of their God" upon them, and also to express their gratitude to the many kind friends who have enabled them to carry out the purposes of the Society. During the past severe winter the Committee have endeavoured conscientiously to distribute the funds committed to their care, and many deserving poor of all denominations have been helped.

The number of Tickets taken at the Depository for dry goods was 234, for groceries 191; and several special grants of money, wood, boots, rubbers, &c. In addition to this a monthly allowance of \$2.00 was given to a helpless invalid.

The Treasurer's Statement shews the receipts and expenditure for the year.

In taking up once more their work of faith and labour of love, the Committee again commend this Society to a generous public; its claims to support are well known; by the system of furnishing tickets to subscribers, deception is rendered almost impossible. The Divine Command coming down to us through the centuries lays the duty of caring for the needy upon each one, and the assurance is given that "with such sacrifices God is well pleased."
