OTHER INTERESTING NOTES. Mr. Geo. Malcolm, of Mitchell High School, has accepted a position in the Stratford Collegiate Institute, as assistant English master, at a salary of \$900 a year.

Any boy would be easily marked. There was disobedience proved. The teacher must be master in the school, otherwise there could be no discipline, no teaching, no learning. The teacher should not be made the easy mark for prosecution by every parent whose child was made to conform to the rules and orders of the teacher."
