An Act to amend the law respecting titles derived through Aliens.

WHÈREAS no person can now be disturbed in the possession of, Preamble. or precluded from the recovering any hereditaments on the ground of his claim being derived from or through an Alien, if such claim was so derived before the passing of the Statute 4 & 5 Vic., 4, 5 V., c. 7. 5 cap. 7, intituled “*An Act to secure to and confer upon certain inhabitants of this Province the Civil and Political rights of natural born British Subjects,*” or after the passing of the Statute 12 Vic., cap. 12 V., c. 197. 197, intituled, “*An Act to repeal a certain Act therein mentioned, and to make better provision for the naturalization of Aliens,*” but no 10 such protection exists in regard to claims so derived during the interval between the passing of these two statutes; and it is expedient to place on as nearly as may be the same footing, all claims derived before the passing of the second statute, whether they were or were not also derived before the passing of the first statute, hereinbefore respectively referred to; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. No person shall be disturbed in the possession of, or shall be pre- Period be-
cluded from recovering any hereditaments in this Province, on the ground of his claim to the same being derived from or through an Alien, after the passing of the statute firstly in this Act mentioned, and 12 V., c. 197
20 before the passing of the statute secondly in this Act mentioned. covered.

II. But if a person claiming an estate as next entitled on account of a person nearer in the line of descent having been an Alien, has, in virtue of such claim taken actual possession of the estate before the passing of this Act and has made improvements thereon,—or if he 25 has sold or parted with or contracted to sell or part with the estate before the passing of this Act, the estate not being at the time in the adverse possession of any person whose claim would then have been good but for his claiming through an Alien, this Act shall not render invalid any right or title to such estate, but such right or title shall 30 remain as if this Act had not been passed.
