BILL.

An Act to amend the Act intituled, "*An Act to incorporate the City of Kingston Water Works Company.*"

WHEREAS *The City of Kingston Water Works Company* Preamble. has acquired more real property, and has erected a steam engine of greater power, than is found to be necessary at present for the supplying of the City of
5 Kingston with water: And whereas it is expedient that the said Company should be empowered to make the most advantageous disposition of their said property, during the time in which it shall not be required for the purposes for which the said Act was passed: Be it there-
10 fore enacted, &c.

That for and notwithstanding any thing contained in the Act incorporating the said Company, it shall be lawful for the said *City of Kingston Water Works Company*, to hold and use any part of the real property now held by them
15 and not necessary for the supplying the said City with water, to and for any uses and purposes which the Directors of the said Company or a majority of them shall by vote declare to be expedient. Company may hold and use their present property.

II. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful
20 for the said Company to lease for manufacturing purposes, or to make any other use or disposition of the extra power of their said steam engine not required for the supplying the said City of Kingston with water, which the said Directors or a majority of them shall by vote
25 declare to be expedient. May lease the extra power of their steam engine.

III. And be it enacted, That this Act shall remain and be in force so long as the said Act incorporating the said
Company shall continue in force, and no longer. Duration of this Act.
