I desire to proceed with all earnestness against those men who in their partisan zeal feel their own nests (hear, hear), encouraging the foreign nations to furnish material to foreign countries for the malignant libels which they utter against this country. (Cheers.)

Now what response are we going to make to this admirable and astonishing outburst of loyalty and affection? Are we worthy of it? Can we rise to the height of an Empire not bounded by the limits of the United Kingdom, but embracing every man of the British race throughout the world? (Hear, hear.)
