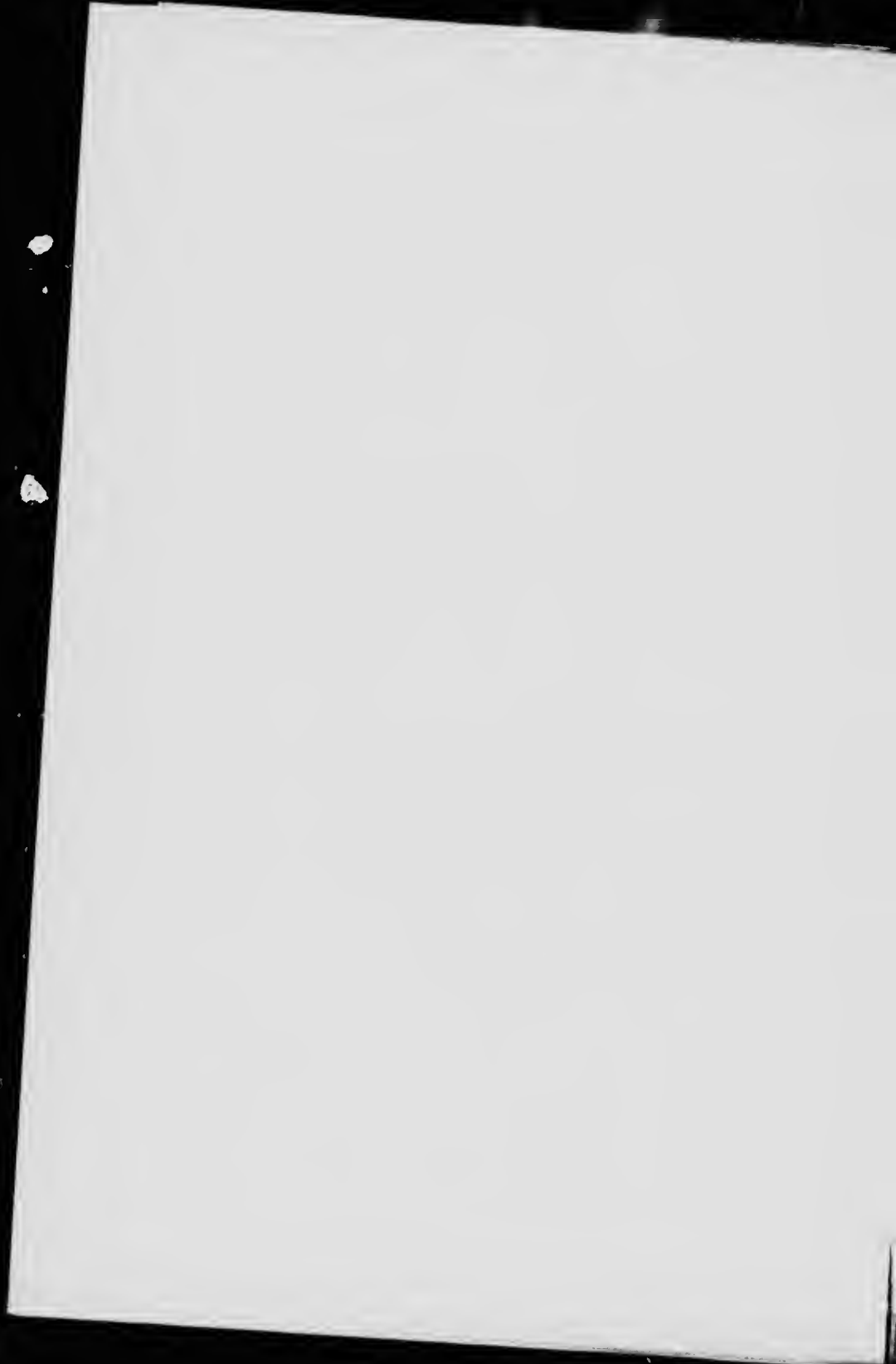
MICROCOPY RESOLUTION TEST CHART

(ANSI and ISO TEST CHART No. 2)



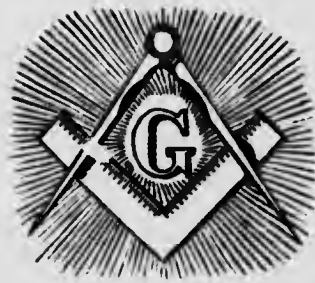
