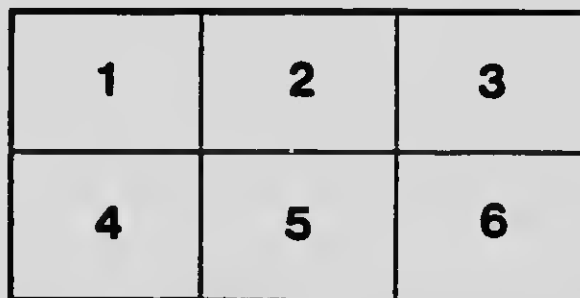
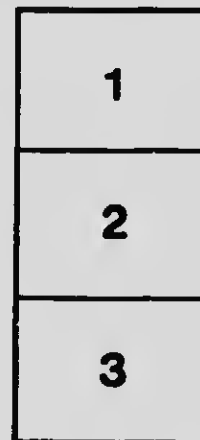

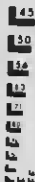

POSTAL REGULATIONS

Most generally required, condensed.
(For complete wording see Official Postal Guide)

FIRST CLASS MATTER LETTERS

All mail matter should bear the street and number (if any) as well as the Postoffice, Province or State. Letters for the General Delivery should be so addressed.

A letter once posted becomes the property of the person to whom it is addressed, and must be forwarded according to its direction. On no application, however urgent, can it be delivered back to the writer, or to any other person.

Letters addressed to mere initials or fictitious names, will not be delivered unless addressed in care of a resident, or to some box in the Postoffice.

POSTAGE.

Letters addressed to places in Canada and the United States, including Porto Rico, Hawaii, Guan and Philippine Islands, 2 cents per ounce or fraction thereof.

Letters addressed to places in Canada must be at least partially prepaid, and those addressed to the United States must be prepaid at least a full rate (2c). Otherwise they will be sent to the Dead Letter Office.

Letters addressed to places in Canada and partly prepaid, will be forwarded subject on delivery to double the amount of unpaid postage.

INSUFFICIENTLY PREPAID LETTERS

For any place in Canada will be forwarded and charged double the deficiency.

The sender of a registered article posted in Canada for delivery in Canada or in any other Postal Union country may entitle himself to a certificate as to the disposal of the said article by the Postmaster at the office addressed on prepayment of an additional fee of 5 cents. All classes of matter may be registered to all destinations in Canada and throughout the Postal Union; and letters may be registered

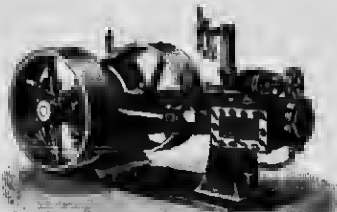

Senders of registered articles are requested to put their names and addresses in the upper left hand corner of the cover.

The public are reminded that registered letters are only carried on trains that are accompanied by railway mail clerk. Hence a registered letter and an ordinary letter posted simultaneously will often be received at different times.

INSURANCE OF REGISTERED LETTERS

Inland Registered Letters, that is, Registered Letters posted at and addressed to a postoffice in Canada, may be insured against loss for amounts not exceeding Twenty-five dollars, on payment of the following fees, in addition to the full postage and registered charges:

Private post cards, duly prepaid one cent each by postage stamp may be posted in Canada for delivery within Canada and the United States.

Private post cards may have a reply-card attached, bearing one cent stamp.

Private post cards may, if prepaid 2 cents, be posted in Canada, addressed to any postal union country.

The limit of size for a Private Post Card is 6 inches long by 3½ inches wide.

The British Postoffice will recognize as entitled to return to this country the reply halves of Canadian Domestic Reply Post Cards upon which the additional one cent postage stamps required have been affixed.

SECOND CLASS MATTER NEWSPAPERS FROM OFFICE OF PUBLICATION

The dispatch of newspapers by mail from office of publication is governed by the regulations of the Postoffice Act, 61 Vic., cap. 29, and all information respecting inclosures, sample copies,

Under 1 oz. ½ cent. All other newspapers or periodicals 1 cent per 2 oz., or fraction. For all other Postal Union Countries, 1 cent per 2 oz., or fraction of 2 oz.

Foreign newspapers reposted in Canada by news agents at a bulk rate of 1 cent per pound. Copies reposted for local delivery, 1 cent per 4 oz.

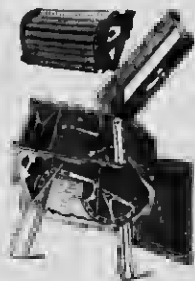

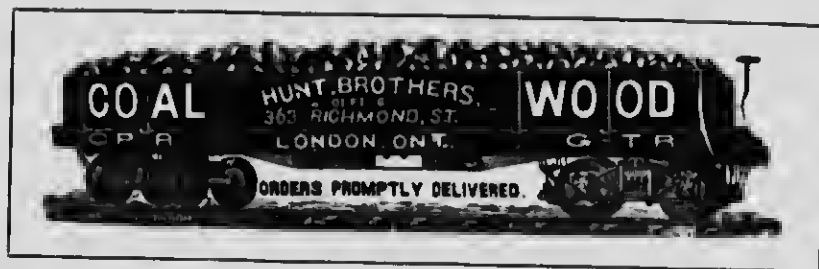
