Shipping Notes. The bark Hazelton, from Charlottetown for Bremen, was towed into the dock on the 26th inst., waterlogged, having been in collision with the ship Malowate, from Liverpool for Calcutta.

Telegraphic Notes. F. Rev. Samuel Almon, a converted Baptist, was ordained in the Grand Street Baptist church yesterday.

Geo. Wright, a pauper, was run over and killed on the Acton Railroad on Saturday night. The body was not discovered until 10 p.m.

Citizens of Chelmsford, Mass., report a perceptible shock of earthquake Sunday morning, shaking the buildings and frightening many people.

The police yesterday made a raid upon a notorious gambling hall in west Third street, capturing implements, cards, etc., together with 32 players.

Fourteen gamblers were arrested at the corner of Spring and Sullivan streets yesterday.

A Philadelphia mother with four small children were discovered last night in a house without fire, food, or sufficient clothing. The police arrested the neighbors who refused necessities for their immediate relief, otherwise they must have perished before morning.

During a row in No. 126 Woodstreet, last night, Lewis Italian, an Italian barber, was fatally injured.

A Philadelphia despatch confirms the statement that the children of the Stanton street orphanage, who were taken to the States, shall be sold to the medical authorities for scientific purposes.

Resolutions adopted by a mass meeting of workmen at Chicago yesterday, that there shall be no more legislation for monopolies, that the State shall operate and control all ways and means of transportation, make education compulsory, make payments weekly instead of monthly and establish savings banks and insurance companies.

Keller, a saloon keeper at 110 Goerck street, yesterday gave a birthday dinner to some friends. A party of invited guests insisted in participating, and upon being bowed out, attempted to break the doorway with bricks and cobble stones.

Police officers Dalton interfered and a fight followed. McGuire, one of the rioters, was fatally shot by Dalton, and several others were arrested.

At a meeting of the International here yesterday, letters were received from the Governors of Virginia, Minnesota and Louisiana and Senator Conkling, in response to the request that these States give land and build houses for European emigrants. These gentlemen had promised to lay the matter before the Immigration Committee of the House of Representatives.
