An Act to vest in Charles Coxwell Small, Esquire, certain
Road Allowances in the Township of Pickering.

WHEREAS all that portion of Public Highway or Road Preamble.
Allowance in the third Range of the Township of Pickering,
in the County of Ontario, one of the United Counties of York,
Ontario and Peel, lying north of the Kingston Road between Lots
5 Numbers 34 and 35, to within the distance of about eleven chains
from the front of the first Concession of the said Township, also that
other portion of Road Allowance lying north of said Kingston
Road, between the third Range of said Township of Pickering and
10 the Town Line Road Allowance, pass through a very rough and
uneven piece of ground traversed by two deep ravines, forming
the bed of the two Rivers known as the Big and Little Rouge,
and a tongue of land of about ten chains in width between the said
ravines crosses the said Allowances known as the Hog's Back,
15 which Allowances for Road have never been used as such, and
from the position and nature of the ground cannot be so used;
And whereas another Road to the east of the said Allowances has
been opened and is used as a substitute for said Allowances across
Lots Numbers 34 and 33, in the third Range of said Township of
20 Pickering, the property of Charles Coxwell Small, Esquire, to the
Kingston Road; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That the Road so laid out through and across the said Lots Num-
bers 34 and 33, the property of the said Charles Coxwell Small,
Esquire, and now travelled as a public highway, shall be and remain
25 a public highway; and that the said original Road Allowances lying
north of the Kingston Road, between Lots Numbers 34 and 35 in
the said third Range of the Township of Pickering, as also that
portion of Town Line Road Allowance between the third Range
of Lots in the Township of Pickering and the second Concession
30 of the Township of Scarborough, lying north of the Kingston Road,
shall be and the same are hereby vested in the said Charles Cox-
well Small, Esquire, his heirs and assigns for ever.

A certain road confirmed as a Public Highway, and certain allowances for Road vested in Charles Coxwell Small.
