AN OLD HINDOO IRON SECRET.

REMARKABLE QUALITIES OF A METAL MADE BY SAMUEL MAXIM.

A New Armor Steel Which Will Greatly Reduce the Weight of Warships Without Lessening Their Quality of Resistance.

A new steel, possessing the most marvelous properties of any steel product known to civilized man, will soon be introduced into the service of the world to be tested for use as armor plate.

The process by which this remarkable steel is made has recently been discovered by Samuel Maxim, brother of Hiram Maxim, of London, England.

Already the new steel has been subjected to the most trying tests, and is regarded by the highest authorities on steel manufacture to be one of the most wonderful and valuable discoveries of the age.

The mode of manufacturing the Maxim steel is supposed to be similar to that used by the ancient Hindoos, and Mr. Maxim claims that the process is almost the same, if not quite identical.

The weight of the armor plate will, in consequence of its reduced thickness, be made much less. The loss in weight of the armor, which would be very large on a great battleship, would enable the ship to reach a much higher rate of speed than is now attained, and at the same time, to resist the most terrific shocks from an attacking ram.

Besides being wonderfully adapted for battleship armor plate, the Maxim steel will be used in the manufacture of light armor, in the making of which the Hindoos are especially expert.

It is, however, in the making of edge tools that Mr. Maxim claims the properties of his steel to be especially adapted. Chisels and drills, made from common iron, are liable to become blunt and inefficient in the process discovered by Mr. Maxim.

Several drills, made of Maxim steel and used by Vickers, Sons & Co., London, steel and iron workers, have been found to wear out much more slowly than drills made of the ordinary iron.

These are the reasons in coin of the standard value of July 14, 1870, which was the date of the first of the metal coins that at that date were the same as at present, the gold unit being a gold piece of 25.3 grains, and the silver unit being the silver dollar of the standard weight of 480 grains.
