A PROTECTIONIST'S PLEA.

Protection Always Necessary—The Right Movement—England's Shipments Summary.

New York, Sept. 12.—Before the senate labor committee to-day John Roach denied that he testified that ships could be built as cheaply here as in England.

Materials were as cheap, but labor was dearer, because labor was better educated here. It was not the first cost of a ship that made it impossible to compete with Great Britain, but the increased cost of capital.

Witness believed in the protection of labor to develop the resources of a country. Without protection no industry, except farming and mining, could be carried on.

In the case of three commodities—cotton, woolen goods and iron—the average value of yearly importations for the last ten years was \$178 millions. It was inflated that year because of money should be paid every year to foreigners, and a shame that while America could feed her population she could not clothe them.

To compete with British manufacturers the American workman must consent to degrade himself to the condition of the laboring classes abroad. Ten years ago England had 142,000 men in sailing merchant service, and 3700 in steam vessels; today 104,000 in sailing and 165,000 in steam.

The past year's earnings of this immense fleet was four hundred millions. This enormous stride of the British was accomplished at the expense of this country. England's foreign trade to-day was 700 times that of this country.

It cost \$13 a ton to produce pig iron in England in 1871 in some parts of the United States. Roach did not think the time would ever come when protection would be unnecessary in this country. He said that if the eight-hour system was established by the government it would be necessary to increase the production of the article to meet the increased cost of production.

If the government would give 150 acres of land to every man who would go into the country and cultivate it himself there would be an easy solution of the labor question.

The stippling prices which arrived here yesterday, was an object of considerable curiosity to the crowds who saw him along the streets and at the exhibition grounds. He is apparently well accustomed to public demonstrations, for he passed through his part of the performance in the simplest and most unassuming manner.

Travelling from country to country, he has seen many English prisons, and he says that he has seen in one part of the world as much as in another.
