Annual Report, 1898.



The termination of the fifteenth year of the Toronto Public Library lays on me the duty of reporting its progress during 1898.

As has been the case with my predecessors in this chair I have much pleasure in calling the attention of the Board to the continued steady increase which has taken place, both in the number of books issued and of readers, an increase the more remarkable as in each successive year we seemed to have reached high-water mark. By referring to the tabulated statement, which is appended, you will see that the number of readers in the Central Circulating Library and its branches have increased from 25,304 to 29,054 and the circulation of books from 557,984 to 608,424, an increase of 50,440. While no information can be furnished as to their profession or occupation, it is satisfactory to know that all classes avail themselves fully of the advantages of the Library, from the Judge upon the bench to the humblest individual who can get a neighbor to vouch for him. When we remember that in the fifteen years in which this Library has been in existence no less than 900,000 books in Science, Fine and Mechanical Art, History and Biography have been taken out for home reading, and judging from the appearance of the volumes carefully read, we can hardly estimate the value of their educative influence.

The Reference Library also, which has grown up to be the most important part of the institution committed to your charge, has become so necessary a resort for consultation that it has almost reached the limits of its space for both books and readers.

Its reading desks are, during a portion of the day, overcrowded, and accommodation is only provided with difficulty. Readers are now continually attracted from distant points in the country and the United States to consult its rare books.

It is in the light of these facts that I regret to call your attention to the action of the City Council in reducing our estimates by the sum of \$5,000. These estimates were based on the most economical running expenses, including a judicious expenditure for books, and were prepared with the utmost care. The reduction made left us without sufficient funds to properly maintain the Library and its Branches throughout the year, and in November a Committee of your Board waited upon the Board of Control to inform them that unless a grant of at least \$2,500 was made, that they would be compelled at once to close two of the Branch Libraries. It was also pointed out that as the Board's estimates amounted to a less sum than the limit permitted by statute, the Council was exceeding its powers in reducing it. The Board of Control acceded to the request of your Committee, and in December placed the amount at their disposal, but so late in the season that the Chief Librarian reported, that the considerable additions to the Library contemplated when the estimates were struck early in 1898, could not be made before the 31st December, and the sum of \$1,800 has accordingly been carried to a special account, to cover purchases compelled to be made in 1899, which should be practically charged to the expenditure of 1898. I must add that the acquisition of books for the Central Library and Branches, but more particularly for the Central Library, is in my opinion quite as important a part of your Board functions as the payment of salaries and the maintenance of the Branches, and the annual estimates, therefore, must always contain a proper item for this purpose. Any curtailment of the appropriation means a reduction of the allowance for books, because all

other items of expense in the Board's estimate are practically fixed charges.

It is with deep regret that I recall the death of our late esteemed Secretary-Treasurer, Mr. John Davy. A severe illness, which seized him almost immediately after our last annual meeting, carried him off in August last. The devoted attention which he displayed in performing his duties in connection with the former Mechanics' Institute, marked him out as one whose services would be essential to the Public Library, when the properties of the Mechanics' Institute were transferred to it in 1882. During all the years of his service he never ceased to advance the interests of the Library.

In previous years the members of the Board found much inconvenience in attending meetings in the afternoon, and formally resolved to alter the hour for the Board and Committee Meeting from 4.15 to 8.00 p.m., and the increased attendance, together with the greater opportunities of becoming cognizant of the affairs of the Board, have shown the wisdom of the change.

In October last, the Senate of Knox College showed their good-will to the Library by donating a copy of the first Volume of the Banner, published in 1843-4, by the late Honorable George Brown, as the predecessor of the "Globe." It thus serves to carry our file back another year and to make that of the "Globe" nearly complete.

The Board has been fortunate in securing the services of Mr. C. Egerton Ryerson as Secretary-Treasurer, in succession to the late Mr. Davy. It seems appropriate that the son of the founder of Public Libraries in Upper Canada should bear an important part in carrying on the work of the largest in the Province.

The accounts of the Library have been audited by the proper

Officers, and Statements of the Receipts and Expenditure, and of the Assets and Liabilities are appended.

I have pleasure in reporting that the Chief Librarian, the Secretary, the Assistants and Employees in the Library have performed their duties in every way satisfactory to the Board.
