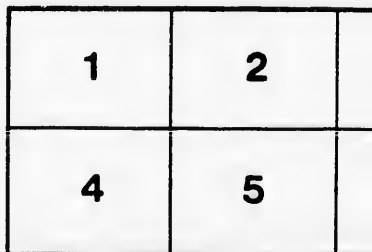

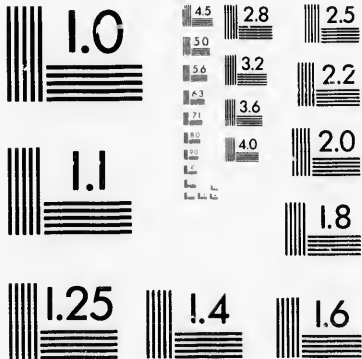

R U L E S  
OF THE  
*MONTREAL LIBRARY.*

1. THE rules concerning the Library are framed by the Proprietors at a general meeting held annually on the first Monday in December, and on other days when called by the Directors.
2. Five Directors and a Treasurer are chosen annually on the first Monday in December, three Directors form a Quorum.
3. The Directors have the charge of the Library, appoint the Librarian, and fix his salary ; they enforce the rules, purchase books, and authorize all payments.
4. Any person approved by the Directors at a special meeting, may become a Proprietor on paying the price of a share, and signing the rules.
5. Any person approved by the Directors may purchase the share of a proprietor (not lapsed) and become a Proprietor in his stead, on signing the rules, paying the arrears, and paying 12/6.
6. Proprietors pay annually on the 7th March five Dollars, neglecting to pay two years, are deprived of the use of the Library, and neglecting during five years, forfeit their share.
7. Any person approved by two Directors may subscribe for six months on paying four dollars, or for twelve months on paying six dollars in advance ; but such persons must be introduced by a proprietor who shall be answerable in every respect for the Subscriber.

*Extrait des Réglemens de la Bibliothèque de  
Montréal, actuellement en force et les plus  
essentiels, année 1804.*

1. LES Réglemens concernant la Bibliothèque, sont dressés et arrêtés par les propriétaires à une assemblée générale, tenue annuellement le premier Lundi de Décembre, et tels autres jours que les directeurs jugeront à propos de les appeller.
2. Cinq directeurs et un trésorier sont élus chaque année le premier Lundi en Décembre : trois directeurs forment un quorum.
3. Les directeurs ont la charge de la bibliothèque, appointent le bibliothécaire, et fixent son salaire : ils mettent en force les réglemens, font l'achat des livres, et autorisent tous les payemens.
4. Toute personne approuvée par les directeurs à une assemblée spéciale, peut devenir propriétaire, en payant le prix de la souscription, et signant les réglemens.
5. Toute personne approuvée par les directeurs, peut acheter la part d'un propriétaire, pourvu qu'elle ne soit pas dans le cas de réunion à la bibliothèque ; et devient propriétaire en son lieu et place, en signant les réglemens, payant les arrérages, et aussi 12s. 6d. pour la mutation et allowance au bibliothécaire.
6. Les propriétaires payent annuellement le sept de Mars cinq piastres ; s'ils négligent de payer pendant deux années, ils sont privés de l'usage de la bibliothèque ; et négligeant de payer pendant cinq ans, leur part dans la bibliothèque est perdue pour eux, et réunie à la bibliothèque.
7. Toute personne approuvée par deux directeurs, peut souscrire pour six mois en payant quatre piastres, ou pour une année en payant six piastres d'avance ; mais telle personne doit être introduite par un propriétaire qui sera responsable pour elle à tous égards.

8. Library days are Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays, from ten till three o'clock.
9. Any Proprietor or Subscriber may take out of the Library, and retain

Any person failing to return a book on the day appointed is subject to a fine of seven pence half penny each running day until it is returned or paid for, and is also till then deprived of the use of the Library.

10. Any book torn or injured in the hands of a Proprietor or Subscriber becomes his, and must be paid by him its full value with that of the set to which it belongs; and it is incumbent on every person to take care that the book is in good order before he takes it out, as he or his security will be deprived of the use of the Library until this rule be complied with.
11. Books lost, to be paid for at the discretion of the Directors.
12. When the fine exceeds four dollars, the excess may be compounded for by the Directors.
