The Fisheries Commission.

The Fisheries Commission has been appointed to take into consideration the North American fisheries question in dispute between the Governments of Great Britain and the United States.

Mr. Joseph Chamberlain, formerly President of the Board of Trade, has been named principal Commissioner on the part of the Imperial Government.
