SEVENTEENTH YEAR

COL. FRED. DENISON DEAD.

MEMBER FOR WEST TORONTO
CUMS TERSE MORNING.

After an illness of four months, during which more than once he was despaired of, Lieut.-Col. Denison of the Governor-General's Body Guards, and M.P. for West Toronto, died at his residence, Rushmore, at 115 this morning, in his 56th year.

A fortnight ago the gallant Colonel was reported considerably better, and was able to come down town and attend to official business. His malady, however, cancer of the stomach, admitted of no hope of permanent recovery, but it was not until yesterday morning that the alarming symptoms recurred in such severity as to preclude hope. The members of the family were summoned, and the Colonel's many friends were apprised of the fast-approaching end.

The brilliant soldier-like qualities of the deceased, his whole-souled devotion to duty, whether on the field, in the courts, or in domestic life, are well known; but it was his gentility, urbanity and gentlemanly demeanor, with an assiduous consideration for others, that obtained for him the high esteem and great popularity he so long enjoyed.

Subjoined is the record of the deceased's career in each of the above capacities.

AN EVENTFUL CAREER.

Identical in the life of the late Lieut.-Col. Denison, M.P.

Frederick Charles Denison was the second son of the late Col. George Taylor and Ann Dawson Denison and was born at Rushmore, near Toronto, on Nov. 22, 1846, the same house where he has just passed away. He was a direct descendant, a great grandson, of John Denison of Hedon, Yorkshire, England, who came to Canada in 1792, and who served in the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, and was killed at the battle of the Chippewa in 1814. F. C. Denison was educated at first privately and when he was in his eleventh year, in 1857, entered Upper Canada College, where he remained until 1863. After leaving U.C.C. he entered upon the study of law, being called to the bar in 1870. He was one of the early graduates at the Military School in Toronto, having for one of his contemporaries Lieut.-Col. James Mason, commanding the Royal Grenadiers. In 1865 the deceased was gazetted cornet in the Governor-General's Body Guard of Cavalry, a corps with which he had an hereditary connection, his father's grandfather before him having had command of that body. He was promoted lieutenant in December, 1867, captain in 1872, major in 1876 and lieutenant-colonel in 1884.

In 1870, on the breaking out of the Red River disturbances, he accompanied Colonel James Macdonell, who was in command of the Canadian expedition sent to suppress the rebellion, as a military officer, or what might more fitly be termed Provincial A.D.C. In that capacity he displayed great zeal and ability, and was mentioned in despatches by Col. Wolsey.

The Nile Expedition.

In the latter part of the summer of 1884 occurred the troubles in the Sudan and the expedition up the Nile. Gen. Wolsey, recently returned from the Nile, rendered by his young Canadian A.D.C., in 1870, determined to place him in command of the expedition. The Nile voyage embodied her for services in the Nile. The telegram offering Lieut.-Colonel Denison the command of the post reached him through the Governor-General on Aug. 28, 1884. He did not wait long to accept of his commission, but most cheerfully signified his willingness to undertake the hazardous and extremely responsible duty. Devoted to duty as Frederick Denison always was, he might well have been excused had he not been invited to accept of a militia office under the control of any Government but that of his native country; he had a large family to support, and he had other interests which would suffer by his absence. None of these things weighed with him, though he was a soldier first, a husband and father afterwards. His duty to his country demanded that when he accepted of a militia office he should do so and he put duty first and other retarding influences in the lowest green brook, and in a few weeks elapsed and the expedition was organized and equipped, sailing from Quebec on Sept. 15, 1884, and reaching the Sudan, Denison and his men were attached to Gen. Earle's brigade and were present at the battle of Kirokran.

Imperial Honors.

For his conduct in the Sudan Lieut.-Col. Denison received the English war medal, the Khedive's bronze star, was created C.M.G., was several times mentioned in despatches and was specially mentioned in the British House of Commons by the Marquis of Salisbury when he covered the campaign.

Before leaving Egypt Lieut.-Col. Denison was attacked with enteric fever and had a long and dangerous illness, from which he only slowly recovered, but eventually entirely regained his health.

As An Alderman.

Lieut.-Col. Denison represented St. Stephen's Ward in the City Council from 1875 until 1881 inclusive, was out of the Council in 1882 and was re-elected in 1883-84. In the latter year he was chairman of the Executive Committee of the Toronto Board of Health, and his presence in the Board was painstaking and conscientious and earned the respect of all those who were brought into contact with him.

Parliamentary Career.

On the dissolution of the Dominion House of Commons in 1887, Lieut.-Col. Denison was elected a Member for West Toronto, and has since that time been a member of the House of Commons. WHOLESALE MURDER OF BABIES.

This Accused Woman is Said to Have Deprived Thirty and Forty Infants of Life.

New York, April 14.—A special dispatch to The Journal from London says: The alleged baby murderer with the suggestive name of Dyer is reported to have committed suicide at Reading yesterday.

She tried to strangle herself with her shoelaces, trying them in the same way as she had done in the left ear, previously as in the case of a "strangled infant" found in the Thames. The man is now watched so closely that suicide is impossible.

It is further learned that the murderer, as formerly attempted, suicide by drowning at Bristol, where she was committed as an insane person. She met the old woman nicknamed "Grannie," her accomplice, while in the Bristol infirmary. The two went to Reading, where "Grannie" is now assisting the police in their investigation.

Thirty Babies Murdered. According to the latest rumors, perhaps thirty or forty babies were murdered during the course of her business in London. The baby found in the house weighed nearly three hundred pounds. A box had also been found which contains a horrid stench. It evidently had contained an infant's body, which afterwards was conveyed to the Thames.

Weaving a Strong Net of Guilt. Slowly but surely the police are weaving a strong net around Dyer, who the latest rumors are still combing the bed of the river. They were every loose end of the thread. This was for they secured a brown paper in which one baby was wrapped, which has been identified by a railway clerk, who avers that it was the covering of a parcel delivered to the prisoner. Proof has also been obtained of one journey of Mrs. Dyer, which began with a baby and a carpet bag, and which ended with Dyer, minus the baby, and an unexplained baby disposed of in the Thames. In every case she exacted from the mother a large sum of money.

Thirty or forty bodies of infants have been found in the Thames within a London mile, and unexplained babies were murdered, perhaps not all by Mrs. Dyer and her male accomplice, the people were alive today.

The editor of The St. James' Gazette says that it is clearly true that some of the babies were murdered in London, that it is not pleasant to think that wholesale child murder on the part of a woman, who was a mother, and in our midst, without public attention being called to it or without the police apparently thinking it worth a special report.

ALTIITUDE AND THE LIGHT.

A Better Vacuum With More Striking Results and Cheaper.

Denver, April 14.—During the exposure of a photographic plate under a Crookes tube at the Homeopathic College yesterday, the students and professors approached a big induction coil, holding an incandescent bulb in his hand. The bulb began to glow with a bright blue light, which lasted as long as it was within a dozen feet of the coil.

On being removed from the influence of the coil the bulb glowed at intervals for ten minutes, when it went out. The Crookes tube again glowed intensely, and the tube was both of lead glass.

The college has ordered a number of Crookes tubes made of this glass, which has been condemned by scientists in the east, but gives good results in the west. The altitude, it is believed, accounts for the high degree of vacuum obtained in the lamps and tubes.

VON KOTZE KNOWS TOO MUCH.

For the German Authorities to Arrest Him on the Charge of Spies.

New York, April 14.—A Berlin special says: Notwithstanding the clamor of the religious and moral elements regarding the arrest of von Kotze, the Reichsbank, The National Zeitung, The Catholicische Volkszeitung and other conservative journals have urged the government of the utmost severity of the law against von Kotze.

Not desiring, however, to outrage public sentiment, the authorities have decided to arrest him on the charge of espionage. He is a man who was killed by von Kotze, to allow his body to remain in the hands of the enemy in honor which would otherwise certainly have been bestowed on the late Marquis of Ceremonies of the Prussian court.

MAKES IT BAD FOR GAMBLERS.

The New York State Legislature Will Not Permit Hired Use of Halls.

Albany, April 14.—In the Senate today Mr. Platt introduced a bill that provides that any person who shall knowingly be a party to the transmission by telephone, telegraph, mail or express, or otherwise, from one State or Territory into another, of any gambling bet or report of such bet, or of the odds quoted on any race or prize fight or other event, or who shall knowingly receive or transmit such reports, or of any lottery, drawing or scheme by means of which a sum of money shall be distributed to one or more persons, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than two years, or by a fine of not more than \$1000, or both, and the second and after offenses by imprisonment only.
