BILL.

An Act to reunite the County of Frontenac and the City of Kingston, for Registration purposes.

(No. 148 of 1863—2nd Sess.)

House in Committee, 4th March, 1864.

MR. WHITE.

QUEBEC:

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An Act to re-unite the County of Frontenac and City of Kingston, for Registration purposes.

WHEREAS divers inhabitants of the County of Frontenac and of the city of Kingston, have by petition to the Legislature represented that the separation of the said county of Frontenac from the city of Kingston, for Registration purposes, is inconvenient to the people of the county and city, and have prayed that the said county and city be re-united for Registration purposes; and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioners: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

10 1. Upon and after the first day of November next, the said county of Frontenac and city of Kingston shall be re-united for the purposes of Registration, and the said county and city shall upon and after the said day form one Registration Division. The Registry Office for the said county shall be kept in the city of Kingston, and the appointment of a Registrar for the city shall have no further effect upon and after the said day.

Preamble.

County and City to be one Registration Division after 1st November 1863.

20 2. The present Registrar of the said County of Frontenac shall, after the said day be the Registrar of the whole County and city, holding office on the same terms as other Registrars; and all future appointments of Registrars shall be for the whole county, including the city as reunited under this Act.

Registrar of Frontenac to be Registrar for the County and City.

25 3. Upon and after the day last aforesaid, all memorials, certificates, register books, calendars, instruments, documents, and papers relating to the registration of deeds, or other instruments or documents affecting real estate in the city of Kingston, and registered in the Registry Office of the city of Kingston, or in any way forming part of the records and muniments of the said Registry Office, shall be transferred to the Registry Office for the county, to be kept at the same place, and shall make part of the registers, records, and muniments, of the said office, and the same shall rank in the order and date of their registry in the said city as if they had in such order and date been registered in the Registry Office for the said county of Frontenac; and the Registrar of the said county shall have the same power and duties with respect to them, and to all searches, certificates, and other matters relating to them, as if the registration of the deeds, instruments, and documents to which they relate had been effected in the said county Registry Office.

Transfer of documents from City to County Registry office, and

duty of Registrar respecting them.

4. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
