### Montreal Stock Market.

**REPUBLIC GOES LOWER—STREET RY. RECOVERS A FEW POINTS—AMOUNTS TRADED IN TRIFLING.**

Montreal, July 27.

Small transfers of shares in thirteen classes of stock were made to-day at prices which were in most cases lower than the previous day's price. Twin City was higher, Toronto Ry. can't be said to have sold lower, Republic was off, but Payne had a little advance. Observers of Wall Street, the condition of which influences the local market, now affirm that more activity will not likely spring up till after the grain has begun to move. There seems to be no reason why strong and active markets should not exist now, yet as a matter of fact, they are sluggish in the extreme. Even the Roads which are showing great earning powers are doing much less than might have been expected. The movement of new crops is an important date and ought to have an influence on market conditions, and owing to this it has been considered as most likely to be the very power to give a waiting market its initial impulsion.

Canadian Pacific—London quotation was down a little to-day, so the 200 shares sold here at 97½, ¼ less than the lowest yesterday. Closing demand 97½, the offer being 97¼.

Twin City at 68 in a deal of 50 shares, showed for the second time this week some activity, and this at the advanced price. Sellers wanted 69½, buyers offering 67½.

Montreal St. Ry. did not retrograde any to-day, selling at 325 ex-div., not a high price compared with 329 of a fortnight ago. Sellers, expecting advance, wanted 327½, and were offered 324. After this week the 2 or 3 points lost lately will be quickly recovered.

Toronto Ry.—At 116, there were sold

225 shares to-day. This price, the same as yesterday's, is a return to the high standard of a fortnight ago. Closing demand was 116½, and offer 116.

Republic—To-day was another day of humiliation to Republic, the price using ½ or 1 lower than yesterday, which was 1 or 2 lower than Friday, which was 2 or 3 lower than the week before, etc. Buyers did not weaken, however, but offered 119½, while sellers wanted 119¼.

Rich. & Ont. sold at the same price as yesterday, in fact a little lower than the price it can generally command. Closing there was asked 110 and offered 109.

Montreal Telegraph sold at about its usual price, 172, closing demand was for this price while the offer was 170.

Payne had 600 shares transferred at 139½ which is 4½ higher than last week's price. There was wanted 140, while 136 was offered.

Dom. Coal Pfd.—Of this security 50 shares changed hands at 116, same price as yesterday. 118 was wanted, 115½ offered.

Dom. Cotton—This week's price for Dom. Cotton has been one or two lower than last week's. 110 wanted with 107 offered.

Bell Telephone—This week's price has been 5 higher than the previous week's. 200 was wanted and 187 offered.

Duluth Pfd sold at 11. The demand was for 11½, the final offer was 11.

Merchants Bank at 170, the unvaried price for a fortnight. 23 shares changed hands, 172 was asked and 169½ offered.

**A BETTER DEMAND — PRICES  
SCRAPING BOTTOM—GOLDEN  
STAR HIGHER.**

There is little to be said of the local market. The board adjourned at a quarter to twelve to enable the members to catch the twelve ton train for Dorval. The demand for stocks was improved and when wanted, shares seemed in poor supply. There is no great change in prices, but stocks which have for some time been pressed for sale could not be purchased at even advances over late quotations.

Golden Star opened at 44½ where 2000 shares changed hands, it was afterwards sold down to 42. It closed firm and could have been sold at 43.

One sale of California was made at 11, but no more could be had at this price. Virtue was neglected though 54 was accepted for 500 shares. It closed nominal about same price would have been paid for more though 40 was the best nominal bid.

Virginia was wanted at around 21 to 22 but none was for sale. This price is really only 17 as an assessment of \$5 per share has lately been paid. Cariboo Hydraulic was steady with 145 bid. Big Three was better. It sold at 15½. Knob Hill was offered and taken at 92½. A few more shares are for sale at same price. Of the good dividend payers the only stock at close range was Republic. It closed at 119 to 11½.

# NEW YORK EXCHANGE.

**BURLINGTON & ATCHISON ROADS SHOW \$1,000,000 AND \$600,000 INCREASED EARNINGS — STOCKS, HOWEVER, ARE INACTIVE.**

New York, July 27.

L. & N. continues to be the favorite and the feature in the speculation in American shares in London.

To-day's quotations in that market for this stock show an advance of  $\frac{1}{8}$ .

The general list is higher, B. O., St. Paul Un. Pacific pfd, and Readings, all showing advances, while the feeling abroad is said to be conservatively bullish. A waiting policy dominates the speculation there.

The item in this morning's "Sun" states that grave fears are entertained for the corn crop in Kansas. No rain has been had in that State of any account, for 16 days, and the crop in every county is said to be suffering. This may lead to some selling of the Grangers and it would not be surprising if the hitherto brilliant prospects of the corn crop should give place to a crop scare, under which some liquidation may take place.

The B. Q. weekly crop report states that the wheat crop along nearly all its lines is being harvested, the crop is not nearly as large as a year ago and conditions have not been as favorable.

The "Tribune" this a.m. states that labor troubles are imminent on the Consolidated roads. The brakemen threaten to strike for a 10-hour day and a slight increase in wages, and it is said they have given the road until Aug. 1st to decide.

The Bank rate of Bank of Eng. remains unchanged.

New York, Noon, July 27.

The failure of the Bank of England to advance its discount rate, was only what was expected. The Bank has strengthened its position during the past week and the tendency of discount rates in the open market in London is no longer upwards.

Cables continue to state that the feeling on Americans is moderately bullish, but that the leading operators are not willing to take any considerable lines until greater activity develops in our market.

The only interesting feature abroad is the rather sharp decline in French routes. This was supposed to be due to fears of disturbances incidental to the dismissal of certain prominent French generals.

The market here opened quiet and with very little outside business. There was some disposition to cover in Malt pfd owing to the statement of one of the officials to the effect that the business was entirely satisfactory, and that not only was the div. earned but that in all probability 3 p.c. on the common will be shown during the coming year. Yesterday's attack on the common and preferred, seemed to be due to the efforts of a disgruntled stockholder to put expert accountants on books. The Co. was quite willing to allow any stockholder to examine the books, but naturally refused to allow outside parties to make the examination.

The feeling on Con. Gas continues bearish. The end of the war is not in sight and there is a good deal of talk not only of a reduced div., but of a possible suspension.

The selling is to a large extent for short account, and inasmuch as the floating supply of the stock is comparatively small, it is quite possible that over selling will take place with its consequent penalty.

London houses bought about 1000 L. N. The stock recovered nearly 1 p. c. of the div. at opening. Considerable interest is taken in the June Statements of the B. Q. and the St. Paul, which should be published during the next few days. It is vaguely rumored that the Burlington road will show an increase in gross earnings of nearly \$1,000,000.

The St. Paul net results are expected to be very satisfactory, and people in close touch with the Atchison road predict that the net increase of this property for June will amount to some \$600,000.

Speculation in S. S. pfd. was somewhat lighter than it was yesterday, but there are evidences of good buying on the decline. Manipulation is apparent in Sugar, but if its object is to attract outside speculation, it may be classed as a failure. The money market is unchanged.

### MINING NEWS.

(Special to Exchange News.)

Vancouver, B.C., July 26.

Robert Jaffray, president of Crow's Nest Coal Company, interviewed this morning, said he was well satisfied with the work going on. It was really development work but they had plenty of coal of exceptional quality and the coke ovens were working full blast. Fifty ovens were now in operation and sixty more would be completed as soon as a delayed shipment of tunnel heads arrived. This would give them a capacity of 118 tons of coke per day. Quite recently a new ten-foot coal seam had been struck and the capacity of the mine is daily increasing. The coal is of a bituminous nature of excellent quality, makes very little ash, about 4 per cent., and gives a fierce heat. The mine is already shipping to Winnipeg, and has shipped large quantities to Brandon, and the company will be able to turn out all that British Columbia will require for some time to come.

Of the coke supplied to the various smelters at Northport, Trail, and Hall Mines, Mr. Campbell, of the latter, said Mr. Jaffray had stated that even coke from English coal could not equal that produced by the Crow's Nest Coal, while experts in giving their opinion on the coal had stated that it ranked next to the best Welsh.

Mr. William Farwell, general manager of the Eastern Townships Bank, and Mr. H. E. Brown, Q.C., a director of the bank from Sherbrooke, Que., are touring the province.

On July 20th first sod was turned for the Cranbrook North Star mine branch of the C. P. R. The road will be 20 miles in length. The work of construction is being done by C. P. R. itself. Tenders were called for some time ago and several contractors figured on the job, but when the tenders were opened the company decided that they were too high.

Geo. E. Berthiaume, of Ottawa, who is in charge of the government working party at present stopping in Vancouver, on its way to the Yukon, says work on which they will be engaged is the construction of the inland telegraph line, Bennet to Dawson. The party will work east from Bennet. They expect to pass the winter and the spring of 1900 in the north. The men are all hardy French Canadians.

Gold dredging is now going ahead rapidly in Cariboo, and before the season closes there will probably be not less than four dredges operating on the Quesnelle and four or five on the Fraser.

Chicago, July 27.

Fairly good demands for export and otherwise keep the transfer of cereals continuous and prevent the large daily receipts from reaching too high an aggregate. Receipts are however, in excess of shipments and this with perhaps over-estimated future supplies makes prices lower and the market quiet and dull. Wheat at Liverpool was cabled as  $\frac{1}{8}$  lower and likely to remain unchanged until more invigorating reports are to hand from America. Corn at Liverpool was  $\frac{1}{8}$  higher and steady at that but very inactive. As usual the superfine weather reports have given place to less pleasant ones. Kansas is said to have had no rain to speak of for sixteen days and to be suffering in consequence. At Chicago all the wheats were  $\frac{1}{8}$  to  $\frac{1}{4}$  lower, all the corns  $\frac{1}{8}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$  lower, all the oats  $\frac{1}{8}$  lower than their closing prices of yesterday. Provisions were slower in opening to-day and did not seem to be getting so high prices as before. Hogs received to-day 27,000, to-morrow's estimate 21,000.
