# UNION MANIFESTO.

"Her Majesty's Government have given to your Despatch, and to the Resolutions of the Conference, their most deliberate consideration. They have regarded them as a whole, and as having been designed by those who have framed them, to establish as complete and perfect an union of the whole into one Government, as the circumstances of the case, and a due consideration of existing interests, would admit. They accept them, therefore, as being, in the deliberate judgment of those best qualified to decide upon the subject—the best framework of a measure to be passed by the Imperial Parliament for obtaining that most desirable result."

Despatch, Colonial Secretary to Governor General, Dec. 3, 1864.

1st. The time has arrived, in the opinion of the undersigned, when the common security, and future prosperity of British America urgently demand a Union of the Provinces.

2nd. A project for effecting such Union having been prepared at Quebec during the year 1864, by delegates from all the Provinces <sup>intended so as to secure as far as possible a fair representation of public</sup>

V. J. L. McConnell, and in all its es M Connors agree <sup>slightly</sup> recommended as a basis of Union, we commend it to the favorable consideration of the Nova Scotia Legislature.

3rd. We believe that a Union of the Provinces will strengthen the tie that connects them with Great Britain, and will indissolubly unite and consolidate them, for all time coming, with the British Empire.

4th. Under the terms of the projected Union, provision is made for the immediate construction of an Intercolonial Railway to connect Halifax, and, by existing and contemplated branch railways, several of the larger towns of Nova Scotia, with the Western and Southern portion of this Continent, and upon terms better and every way more favorable, than could ever before be obtained, and such as ought, we think, to be accepted.

5th. If the project of a Union of the Provinces were rejected in Nova Scotia, and with it the terms for securing an Intercolonial Railway, we see no prospect of it ever being constructed.

6th. In view of an abrogation of the Reciprocity Treaty, we are of opinion that every reasonable encouragement should be afforded for creating and sustaining a manufacturing interest in Nova Scotia, in order that the farmer and the fisherman may find a home market as far as possible, for their productions, and the manufacturer, in turn, a nation of consumers for the proceeds of his skill and labor. Otherwise we believe that a heavy drain for the precious metals in return for foreign manufactures, will speedily set in upon our people, and tend greatly to the impoverishment of the country, and the embarrassment of all classes.

7th. In case of a disturbance of the public peace between Great Britain, or any of her Dependencies, and the United States, from any cause

whatever, we consider the Union of British America a chief means of our preservation as an integral portion of the Empire. But as a preventive against the calamities of war, nothing in our estimation is so essential as compliance with the recommendation of the British Government, to unite with each other, and thereby, in the language of Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies, "secure for their posterity throughout all future time the advantages which they enjoy as subjects of the British Crown, by establishing as complete and perfect a Union of the whole into one Government, as the circumstances of the case, and a due consideration of existing interests will admit."

8th. Upon reference to public documents, it is ascertained beyond doubt that in 1863 the people of Nova Scotia paid into the public treasury in Customs and Excise duties, collected under existing tariffs, at the rate of \$2.60 per head of the population, while Canadians under their tariffs paid but \$2.36 per head. We therefore feel confident that such a Union as that projected by the Quebec Conference, and recommended by the Imperial Government, is not likely to prove oppressive to those who are accustomed to pay the larger tax per capita, even if the common country should demand further sacrifice for common protection, while under the projected constitution tariffs and taxes will be uniform, and so adjusted as to bear equally upon all.

9th. We further believe most confidently that the *prestige* which Union will give to British America, the security which it will obviously ensure to its people, and the prosperity at home and the credit abroad which it promises to the country as a whole, contrasted with the great pecuniary burdens which, for many years to come, must be borne by the people of every other part of North America, will, with the continuance of a peace for which the proposed Union is the best guarantee, ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> go to the United Provinces, and that the ~~people~~ <sup>people</sup> below that of Nova Scotia at this moment.

10th. The subject of a Union of all the Colonies has, at various times, engaged the attention and secured the advocacy of nearly all the leading public men of Nova Scotia. A project has at last been worked out by men of diverse sentiments, of adverse polities, of various religious beliefs, representing all classes and all creeds—Her Majesty's Government have had it under consideration, and already stamped it with their approbation—the British Press has ranged itself almost unanimously upon the same side. It is now about to be committed to the Legislature for consideration. We trust it will there receive that grave, calm, and candid deliberation, which a subject so momentous in all its aspects demands. It is so transcendently above and beyond all local, sectional, or party questions, that, while discussing it politicians may, ~~we~~ think, forget the past, and look with a single eye to the future.
