This was the edifying conclusion of a spiritual retreat given for them by the Rev. Father, Most Reverend by other priests. The success of this mission amply repaid the good Fathers for the labors of the mission. Happy Colombia, that is blessed with an army that is truly Christian!

England's Return to Catholicity.

At the time of O'Connell's Catholic Emancipation Bill, English hostility to Catholicism had somewhat abated, although a spirit of distrust still rankled in the Protestant heart of the nation, against the ancient faith. While this was so, it was vaguely believed and admitted that Catholics had at least a right to live, but it was considered a very dangerous experiment to increase the number of Catholics of Catholic relief passed into law, was partly due to the foresight of British statesmen, but primarily to the extraordinary influence of the great tribune who championed the Catholic cause.

Yet, says a correspondent of the Journal des Devoirs, it is a flourishing institution. This is due in part to the fact that ecclesiastical influence is strongly exerted on behalf of the only Roman Catholic University in Canada, while sentimental inhabitants see in it a relic of France.
