

THE OLD RED LION HOTEL. A CONVENIENT LOCATION.

When little York was a hamlet, and all that district north of King-street, was a wilderness of woods and fields, a Mr. Player received from the Crown the patent of 300 acres of land upon the corner of which was built afterwards the "Red Lion" for the accommodation of travellers from the northern country. This property afterwards passed into the hands of a French Canadian, named McLaughlin, who sold it early in the present century to Daniel Tiers, and by whom the hotel, as it now stands, was built in 1808. There are some people living yet who remember Tiers, and speak of him as a typical wide hotel-keeper, with the characteristic tendency of his class of that period to give circular opinions on current social and political questions. Of the first proprietor of the "Red Lion," a writer in the Canadian Magazine for March, 1833, published at York, gives the following amusing reminiscence:

An old acquaintance of mine, the landlord of the "Red Lion," who was a Jolly fellow, although his name was Tiers (what his wife's name was before marriage he does not know) Tiers dropped upon the word and blotted it out forever, and he must retire upon the name. I myself was once conversing for a seat in the parlour, and happened to see a man who let me have some wild land, that being considered the only qualification necessary in a section time, and country. This was one of the elevated and patriotic style, which the section time produced. "There," says he, "You're better off than I am, for I have got a name for the never a steak you get in this country fit to eat for any man's dinner."

This is all that can be said to commemorate the first landlord of the Red Lion and its early history. The mechanic who hewed the timber, put the frame together, and for four years afterwards he died fighting gallantly in behalf of his king and country. This was one Sanders, who came over with Governor Simcoe and settled in the immediate neighborhood of the Red Lion. He was killed in the blowing up of the Old Fort in the war of 1812. The value of land and property during Tiers' time was very small; it is known that he offered the hotel and the two hundred acres to Mr. John Smith's father for \$400, which of course was refused owing to the valueless character of the land. It was not until the troubles of the year 1820 and '37 that the Red Lion came into prominence as a place of public entertainment and accommodation. The house was then very well settled and farmers from Holland's Landing and other places were compelled to leave their produce to York, sometimes taking from two to three days in their journey. In this way it was crowded almost every evening with farmers, who stopped there during the night and as daybreak wended their way to the various markets, staying at the Red Lion in preference to crossing at once to the town the farmer added double toll for the extra distance to come to Yonge, as he could go and come back the same day. This made the Red Lion, especially at a time when political feeling ran high, the most important public resort in the district, these farmers met and discussed (very likely over Bow Burn's piping hot toddy) the future prospects of the country, the political questions which agitated the people, and the social life of the country and Parliament which ruled Upper Canada at that time. It was at the Red Lion that the election of representatives for the Home district was held, and in those days the voting being prolonged for a week the Red Lion presented an animated and sometimes disorderly appearance.

It was not long without a well patronized in the shape of half-pay officers, who settled in the immediate neighborhood, giving, as was claimed, an aristocratic character to the place. The writer on going from the Red Lion to ball-room yesterday almost felt that he was treading on holy ground. During the last seventy-nine years the Red Lion has been in existence what some it must have been the resort of. And if it could speak what a volume of interesting light it would shed on people now gone over to the great majority! It was in this very hall that the first political meeting many a grey-headed citizen of Toronto or settler of the adjoining districts met that woman who was the partner of his joy and sorrow.

Here met the radical politicians of the time and the ultra-conservative of the time, the oligarchy of the period, and formulated the resolutions which afterwards became incorporated in the constitution of the country. It was in this very room that William Lyon Mackenzie was presented in 1838, on his expedition from the Legislature with a gold chain and medal by his sympathizing friends, and it was from the Red Lion three hours afterwards that he, together with 2000 of his followers on horseback and in double-decked sleighs, headed by Highland pipes, started in procession down Yonge-street to save the Government and the Family Compact by their quarrel and the rescue of the Red Lion. This itself gives the Red Lion more than a social prominence, for within its walls was the birthplace of a political party, and the freedom of the electorate in Canada.

It is not necessary to prolong this obituary of an at one time famous hostelry. The building and inside arrangements are as yet in a remarkably good state of preservation, considering that it has weathered almost eighty winters, but this will not save it from the sweeping spirit of the times. It will be forgotten; so, too, the trough which has watered countless of the heads of the nation, the bell which rang out the arrival of the stage coaches and warned the traveler, impeding over the refinements of a Fiers, Burns, Price and a Kirk, that it was again about to pursue its northern or southern journey, is heard no more; the voice of the country cry is no more heard from the bar-room; and finally, the strains of sweet music and the sounds of the merry dance heard at one time from the quiet ball room are all enveloped in the past; but the Red Lion will live in history as a political factor, as an historic and social landmark.




