CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE I.—This shall be known as the Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Canada, and shall be composed of all persons who shall pay one dollar annually to its funds.

ART. II.—The Board of Management shall consist of a President, who shall be the officiating Bishop, nine ministers, three of whom shall be Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, and Secretary, and three laymen, all of whom shall be elected by the General Conference.

ART. III.—The Board shall print and publish the General Report of the Society annually, together with the names of those who have paid one dollar and upward.

ART. IV.—Whenever the Board shall determine to establish missions beyond the bounds of an Annual Conference, it shall pay the expenses of such Mission or Missions, provided the appropriations already made to the Annual Conferences shall not be interfered with.

ART. V.—It shall be the duty of the Secretary to present a report to each Annual Conference of the state of the funds and the amount appropriated to the Conference for the ensuing year, and also an estimate on the amount expected for the funds of the Society from the Conference.

ART. VI.—The Board shall meet annually in the last week in June, or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the call of the President, the place of meeting to be decided by the Board.

ART. VII.—It shall be the duty of each Annual Conference to form within its bounds, a Conference Missionary Society, which shall appoint its own officers, fix the term of membership, and otherwise regulate its own administration, but it shall pay all its funds to the Treasurer of the Society, excepting the Niagara Conference, which may retain eighteen per cent. of its actual income to pay its existing debentures, and as soon as they have been fully paid, that Conference shall likewise pay all its funds to the Society.

ART. VIII.—It shall be the duty of every Secretary of a Conference Auxiliary Society to forward annually to the Secretary of the Society a list of all subscribers.

ART. IX.—The Board shall require regular Quarterly communications to be made by each of the Missionaries on the respective Missions to the Secretary of the Society, giving information of the state and prospects of the various Missions on which they are employed.

ART. X.—Every person paying Five Dollars annually shall be entitled to an Annual Report, and any one presenting a donation of Twenty-five Dollars shall be a life member.

Annual Report.

TO THE PATRONS OF THE MISSIONARY SOCIETY OF THE METHODIST
EPISCOPAL CHURCH IN CANADA :

Herewith is submitted the Report of the Society for 1880-81, showing the amount raised and the expenditure, both of the Parent Board and the Auxiliaries. The Missions in Manitoba are under the care of the Parent Board, constituted by the General Conference for the whole Church ; those in Ontario, of the Auxiliaries, each Annual Conference having its own Auxiliary and controlling its own work. The Manitoba Missions are sustained by assessments upon the funds of the Auxiliaries.

The figures show, first, that with a membership of over 27,500 we raise \$12,500 for missions ; or, but an average of forty-five cents per member. If our entire constituency of 125,000 is considered, the average is but ten cents a person. Second, that the Board in the present state of the funds, dares not lay upon the Conferences a sufficient amount per year to provide for the remote work, so that the Society is necessarily in debt, and some of its resources must be consumed in the payment of interest upon money borrowed—a condition of things unfortunately too common with enterprises of all the Churches. Third, that, therefore, the work in Manitoba cannot be extended as the occasion demands. Fourth, that though the amounts voted to the appropriation fields in Ontario are year by year too small for the preachers at work on them, even these small amounts can not be paid, but the Missionaries must be satisfied with a percentage and suffer from delay. Fifth, that the amount raised by the Church for missions has not increased materially for several years, not having kept pace even with the growth in membership. Sixth, that we are hindered in enlarging the work in Ontario as opportunity offers, not being able to enter inviting appropriation fields. And seventh, that there is a wonderful uniformity in the smallness of the contributions of even our wealthy men, and those growing wealthy from year to year, disclosing a lamentable lack of interest in the great subject.

We confess this state of things would be disheartening, were it not for the following considerations: First, the large amounts laid out in church and parsonage building, and the consequent great increase of Church property; and, second, the heavy demands of the building and endowment funds of our colleges. Here, as elsewhere likely, everything cannot be done at once; and, taking all things into consideration, our people are probably contributing as liberally as any in the Dominion.

The Board had cheering reports from Manitoba, where the membership is increasing both by immigration and the conversion of sinners to God. The church property there is worth about as much as our Society has expended in the Province. The Western outlook, then, is cheering. In Ontario there has been an ill-founded prejudice against the expenditure of missionary money in towns and cities, much to the damage of our work. It is said, there is great wealth there and the people can take care of themselves. All this may be socially and commercially true; but, religiously, it is an entire mistake. The towns and cities, the marts and centres, the aggregations of men, are the mission grounds of the globe to-day. They who make the cities rule the world. The deepest necessities and grandest opportunities are in the massing populations. The missionary apostles sought out the seat of the schools, the shrines of the great temples, the capitals of empires, and the fount and focus of civilization and trade. Why should we, under unjustifiable prejudice, do otherwise? Where there is an opening among the teeming multitudes of the cities, we ought to devote missionary funds to the work and press in to accomplish our part in the salvation of men.

The towns and cities of Ontario so demand our attention, as do also the growing communities of Manitoba and the North-West. Every patriot, as well as every Christian, will rejoice at the prospect of the peopling of that broad and fertile land. If we are going to maintain our position as a Church in this Dominion, we must have to do with the religious provision for the ingathering population. There is no alternative. We must here take our burdens and do our work, or prepare to vacate these British Provinces. The Church has already indicated what is her mind in the matter, and God has abundantly blessed her enterprises. Who can doubt that faith, courage, humility, liberality, prayer and labor will continue to be blessed of God?

and do it more efficiently? Let our hearts be filled with gratitude for the blessings of God on the work hitherto. But the only way to prove gratitude here is to labor on, and work more faithfully. The Board desires the provision for Manitoba this year to be a specialty and made early, that it may not interfere with subsequent efforts. We trust our preachers and people will respond promptly and heartily to this call of the Board. Take the year through, we surely ought to raise \$20,000. This would not be burdensome, and it would give our missionary operations more than double power. There are Churches that raise more than a dollar per member every year as missionary money. Why should not and can not we? The pressure of local enterprises may be upon us; but we can not, dare not neglect the mission work.

How comes it to pass that men and women of wealth do not rise above the dollar per year for this cause? Every year just a dollar; just that and nothing more; oftener under it than over—even though during the year there has been increase of substance and worldly goods? How comes it to pass that men give the dollar when they begin poor, and give no more when they have grown rich? How comes it to pass these professing Christians among us in fine clothes, with broad fields and gay equipages, have but a paltry annual contribution from that for the mission work? How comes it to pass that reputed disciples of the Crucified One can support themselves in costly pleasure, abide in ease, or roll in luxuries when the purchase of Jesus' blood is perishing, and men, brethren, are famishing for the bread of life. Truly we have need to humble ourselves before God, to put on sackcloth and confess our sin. We need not flatter ourselves we are doing "pretty well." Our worldliness and sloth are our ruin. Throughout the Church, ministry and membership, we need renewed consecration that we may receive the baptism of power. How can we look up for the aid of the Holy Spirit in preaching the gospel and we shut up our bowels of compassion from those that perish for lack of the gospel?

When we consider what God hath wrought by the little expenditure of means and energy we have made, we have every reason to be at once humiliated and encouraged. What honor the Omnipotent One hath put upon us in making us fellow laborers with Himself, holy angels and good men in the gospel! He hath given us a membership of nearly 30,000, many efficient ministers of grace, many Sabbath Schools, the press, the colleges, the home and remote missions, ever widening more and more

fruitful fields, and large and rapidly growing church property, increasing facilities for usefulness. What have we done to merit this? Is this a day to be disheartened and withhold? Is this a day to be lifted up and indifferent, despising the Lord that bought us, and His claims upon us? Nay! nay! this is the day for repentance and tears, for confessions and prayers, for consecration of heart and substance to God; for entreaty that he may raise up men for the gospel work, and for devotion of our means to spread gospel truth to the ends of the earth. Beloved brethren and friends, let us by our contributions and prayers make this our most successful missionary year.

RICEVILLE.

This mission has enjoyed a good degree of prosperity during the past year. Spiritually, the fire has been burning with a steady glow; although, owing to a press of other labors and study, we have not held any special revival meetings. From a sense of duty our Church-register has been cut down. Finances—Paid minister's salary, \$400; missions, \$70; college, \$9; other funds, \$22; raised for Parsonage Building Fund, \$300. We have three churches, and a deeded lot at the Fournier Appointment, where another is to be built. Membership, one hundred and five.

NEWINGTON.

Newington Mission, in the County of Stormont, is one of the outposts of Episcopal Methodism, being the farthest to the east of any place to which our ministers are sent, excepting Riceville. There are but five appointments, and yet it is a circuit of "magnificent distances," since some of the people live on the St. Lawrence, and others in the township of Cambrige, distant about forty miles. Notwithstanding our remote place and scattered people, they are endeavoring to "hold the fort," and, by the blessing of God and assistance from the Church, will succeed. We have a good parsonage and three churches, yet have to contend with quite a heavy church debt. Raised for minister's salary, \$310. Our missionary contributions are small, owing—1st. To the impracticability of holding the meetings when first appointed; 2nd. Before they were held the charge had been canvassed in the interest of the Ottawa Church. Membership, one hundred and thirty.

This Society was organized and preparations made for work during the Summer and Fall of 1876. In the Spring and Summer of 1877, some of the Conferences and Camp-Meetings of our Church were visited by the then Corresponding Missionary Secretary, the late Mrs. J. R. Jaques, Auxiliaries formed, Pledges for Life Members, and Members secured; Missionary circles in a few S. S. were also started. As it was something *new* to our ministers and laity, a certain amount of prejudice had to be overcome, which retarded the work and limited the usefulness of its members.

At the General Conference of 1878, a memorial was presented by the Board of Managers asking for recognition that our labors might be systematized, thus becoming more effective, and in compliance we find in the General Conference Reports a clause recognizing us as one of the regular institutions of the M. E. Church in Canada. Since then the Society has been slowly progressing, and we feel that it is now in a fair way to succeed if the women of the church are only faithful to their privileges, that the time has come for them to become actors and benefactors in this behalf, that in no way can they work as effectively or in any cause that will show the fruits of their labors as quickly as in raising funds for the Missionary cause. This Society is in no way intended to interfere with regular missionary work, but to supplement it in organizing and carrying on

Mission circles in S. Schools, in banding together in Auxiliary Societies, the women of our church giving them a common object to work for, a general fund to raise. In examining the statistics of any church we find that the women take no mean part in raising and supplying funds for any and all local church enterprises, then why can we not as a united band rally in strong force to the assistance of our noble corps of missionaries.

The following extracts from our Constitution may be of use to some :

ARTICLE I.—NAME.

This Association shall be called "The Woman's Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church of Canada."

ARTICLE II.—PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Society shall be to encourage and unite the efforts of Christian women in mission work, both at home and abroad.

ARTICLE III.—MEMBERSHIP.

The payment of one dollar annually shall constitute membership, and twenty dollars life membership. Any person paying one hundred dollars shall become an Honorary Manager for life, and a contribution of three hundred dollars shall constitute the donor an Honorary Patron for life.

ARTICLE IV.—ORGANIZATION.

The organization of this Society shall consist of a Board of Managers and Auxiliary Societies.

ARTICLE V.—BOARD OF MANAGERS.

SEC. 1.—The management and general administration of the affairs of the Society shall be vested in a Board of Managers consisting of the Missionary Secretary of the Woman's Missionary Society, Corresponding Secretaries representing each Annual Conference, and five other ladies to be chosen annually by the Board of Managers. Said Board of Managers shall meet at Belleville the third Tuesday in June, 1877, and annually or oftener thereafter, at such time and place as the Board shall annually determine.

SEC. 2.—The duties of the Board of Managers shall be,—

1st. To receive the report of the Treasurer and to appropriate monies found in the treasury in such ways as shall be deemed best in accordance with the purposes and method herein indicated.

2d. To take into consideration the interest of the entire work of the Society, including the employment of missionaries and the designation of their fields of labor, and to devise means for carrying forward the work, fixing the amount necessary to be raised and the work to be undertaken by the Society.

3d. To transact any other business that the interest of the Society may demand ; provided, nevertheless, that all the plans and directions of the Board of Managers shall be in harmony with the Constitution.

ARTICLE VI.—AUXILIARY SOCIETIES.

Any number of ladies contributing each one dollar annually may form a society auxiliary to the Woman's Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church by appointing a President, three or more Vice-Presidents, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary and Treasurer, who, together, shall constitute a local Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VII.—RELATION TO THE MISSIONARY AUTHORITIES OF THE CHURCH.

SEC. 1.—This Society will work in harmony with and under the supervision of the authorities of the Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and be subject to their approval in the employment and remuneration of missionaries, the designation of their fields of labor, and in the general plan and designs of the work.

SEC. 2.—All missionaries supported by the Society shall be approved by the constituted missionary authorities of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and shall labor under the direction of the authorities of the Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and of the particular mission of that Society in which they may be severally employed; and they shall be subject to the same rules and regulations that govern the other missionaries in those particular missions.

ARTICLE VIII.—CHANGE OF CONSTITUTION.

This Constitution may be changed at any annual meeting of the Board of Managers by a two-thirds vote, notice of the proposed change having been given at the previous annual meeting; but Article 8th shall not be changed except with the concurrence of the Board of Managers of the Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church.

We would have wished that this our first general report might have been fuller of details, but owing to the partial lists furnished in most cases up to the present year, we felt that it would not be fair to those whose names were not furnished and yet who had been contributors to publish those partial lists, therefore we have merely given the sum total. In the future we earnestly urge all parties sending monies to furnish names of the persons contributing, also the Circuit and Conference in which said contributors live, as we wish each circuit and station to get the proper credit in this the Annual Report.

We can assure our subscribers that whenever a request is made for their monies to be appropriated to any special field of mission work proper, we will comply with it if it be in accordance with our Constitution so to do.

The balance on hand at the Annual Meeting, sixty dollars, was ordered to be forwarded to the Missionary Board for the relief of our work in the North-West, and it is to this field of labor we wish to especially direct our energies.
