Venor on Coming Weather. Venor, the Canadian weather prophet, writes to the Montreal Witness:—"December having seen the intense cold anticipated by me over a large portion of the Dominion, I am encouraged to attempt a step or two farther, and from the same standpoint in my theory from which my forecast was made, it seems pretty certain that we shall have to record at least two more terms of severity during the present winter, and it is an interesting problem to determine when each of these may be expected to occur. To determine, if possible, this point, I have carefully studied my charts of our winters as far back as the winter of 1869-1870, and have arrived at the following 'probabilities': viz.: That the next marked severe term is likely to occur between the 5th and 15th days of January, or very close upon these dates. This will be severe and probably equal if not exceed the December cold term. The third 'ally,' which I think will be the severest of the three, is likely to come upon us in proximity to the 8th of February and continue for three or more days. Two other 'dips' of minor importance will probably be located towards the end of February and close to the 15th of March respectively. Between these two cold periods there are likely to occur two or more generous thaws, probably with rain."
